LEASE - GRIMMETT & BRADFORD WARE PROPERTY:

LEASE - BOAT RAMP PROPERTY:

The lease on the Boat Ramp Property, held by the Town of Krotz Springs, expires on April 23, 2024.

OTHER BUSINESS:

GENERAL LIABILAITY INSURANCE:

The Port's General Liability Insurance will expire on February 25th. Cindy has already met with Blair Briggs, with Forth Insurance, to go over the Port's building and property coverage. She will let the Board know when Blair sends in an estimate for coverage for 2024-2025.

ST. LANDRY PARISH GOVERNMENT:

All Commissioners were given a copy of the Public Notice advertised by St. Landry Parish Government requiring all of the appointees made by them to various boards, along with their clerical staff, attend yearly legal and financial training. Cindy contacted Parish President, Jessie Bellard, to say that the Port should not have to attend the training because the Port is created by State Legislator and the Port abides by state statutes, Mr. Bellard replies, that, yes, all Parish appointees and clerical staff of those associated boards will need to attend.

SURFACE LEASE AGREEMENT:

The Memorandum of Lease has been received from Alon on the Surface Lease Agreement (19.86 acres).

BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT:

Rigid has worked out their issues with the Workforce Commission. Once that is complete, the final paper work on the Bank Stabilization Project can be sent to DOTD - Port Priority Program to get approved to release the final retainage to be paid to Rigid.
