# I. Call to Order - Chairwoman, Teresa Lawrence

- Roll Call A quorum was confirmed. The above-named Commissioners attended the meeting.
- **Approval of Board absences for today, May 27, 2021** Mayra Pineda motioned, seconded by Larry Katz to excuse Barry Breaux's absence. The motion passed unanimously.
- **Approval of Minutes for April 29, 2021** Mayra Pineda motioned, seconded by Tom Gennaro to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.
- Presentation Mid Barataria Sediment Diversion presented by: Caitlin Berni of Berni Consulting, LLC and Therese Walker, Emergent Method
  The presentation addressed Louisiana's Land Loss Crisis Mid-Barataria
  Sediment Diversion, Draft Environmental Impact Statement & Draft Restoration Plan. Data was provided regarding economic impact, land building capability,



marsh creation comparisons, other project benefits, impacts and mitigation measures for: dolphins, brown shrimp & oysters, communities outside flood protection, and environmental justice communities & populations.

The presentation included an overview of project objectives, findings and key
takeaways of the full Market Study & Feasibility Analysis and thorough Site
Investigation. Recommendations/next steps for "Phase 2" included PreDevelopment Planning, Land Use Master Planning and Strategic Business Plan,
Governance and Funding.

  - Todd Tournillon, with Richard CPAs, presented the JEDCO Financial Statement Audit as of and for the year ending December 31, 2020. The presentation included component units for Forward Jefferson Corporation (FORJ) and JEDCO Development Corporation. At the conclusion of the presentation, Mickal Adler motioned, seconded by Lesha Freeland, to defer this item to a later date to allow Commissioners more time to review the 58-page report, and to schedule a special meeting on June 9, 2021 to be brought back to the Executive Committee to consider for approval. The motion passed unanimously.
- Approval of Chairwoman Teresa Lawrence's travel expense Jerry Bologna Along with Jerry Bologna, Chairwoman Teresa Lawrence will participate in the Jefferson Chamber's Engage 2021 Intercity Trip to Tennessee. The event will focus on public education and workforce development, public-private partnerships and infrastructure development, and regional branding. Michael Kraft motioned, seconded by Mayra Pineda to approve Chairwoman Lawrence's travel expenses. The motion passed unanimously.
- Resolution approving the reappointment of Mr. Mark Madderra and Mr.
  Richard Poche, and approving the appointment of Mr. Matthew Zeringue,
  replacing Mr. Ryan Breaux, to the JEDCO Architectural Review Committee,

#### IV. President and CEO Report - Jerry Bologna

- New staff introductions Ms. Anthea Smith joined the Economic Development Services Department and will serve in the capacity of Business Retention and Expansion Specialist. Ms. Huyen Nguyen joined the Finance Department and will serve in the capacity of Business Development Officer.
- On June 10, 2021, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will award JEDCO, Jefferson Parish, and the City of Westwego with a \$600,000 federal grant to assess potential Brownfield sites on the West Bank.
- Avondale Marine recently signed a lease with a tenant. JEDCO and Avondale Marine continue to meet with other potential prospects for the site.
- HB 472, relative to specialty license for the production of medical marijuana, was involuntarily deferred in the House. Next week, Rep. Marino will present HR 113 which creates a special commission to study and make recommendations concerning medical marijuana laws and regulations.
- All future meetings of the JEDCO Executive Committee, Finance Committee and quarterly Board of Commissioners will be held in-person without an option to participate virtually.
