

At 11:45 a.m. on May 26, 2023, Ronald B. Blicht called the meeting to order at the Board's office in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, with the following members present:

President Blicht welcomed everyone back to the meeting, then reviewed the agenda and recognized public comment time.

#### **Minutes**

Ducote presented and noted one error on page two of the December 2022 minutes.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Singh, seconded by Ms. Kobila, to approve the minutes of the December 16, 2022, board meeting, amended to correct the error noted by Mr. Ducote.

#### **Legal Counsel Report**

##### **HB333 update**

Introduced during the 2023 legislative session was HB 333, which sought to sunset the exemption for civil engineers contained in R.S. 37:155. Spaht summarized the presentation of this bill to the House Commerce Committee, which is available online. At the request of the American Council of Engineering Companies of Louisiana (ACEC-L) and the Louisiana Engineering Society (LES), the Task Force composed of architects and engineers and their representatives, which had previously met to consider issues related to the incidental practice of architecture and engineering will be reconvened to discuss a potential path for closing the loophole. Mr. Blicht appointed Mr. Elberson to participate in the Task Force on behalf of the board.

##### **Rule §1103 & §1111 – rulemaking update**

Spaht reported that on November 20, 2022, the Notice of Intent for the proposed amendment of Rule §1103. Individuals Registered in Other States and the proposed adoption of Rule §1111. Dependents of Healthcare Professionals had been published in the *Louisiana Register*. On January 19, 2023, the Occupational Licensing Review Commission (OLRC) made its final review of the proposed changes and authorized the board to promulgate the proposed rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (“APA”).

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Brossett, seconded by Mr. Cardone, to adopt the proposed changes to LAC 46:I: Chapter 11. §1103 Individuals Registered in Other States and §1111. Dependents of Healthcare Professionals, subject to publication of these rules in the June 20, 2023, issue of the *Louisiana Register*.

##### **Rule §1907(E) amendment**

Spaht reported that, after its review of the laws and rules of other jurisdictions and much discussion, the Complaint Review Committee (CRC) had concluded that the amount of fines imposed upon firms found to have practiced architecture with an expired certificate of authority should be reduced to one-half the fines for individual architects found to have practiced with an expired license. The CRC recommended that the Board amend its Rule §1907(E) General Disciplinary Guidelines to reduce the fines imposed upon firms found to have practiced architecture with an expired COA in accordance with this recommendation. The board accepted this recommendation, and it authorized and instructed Spaht and Staff to commence rule-making to amend this rule in accordance with the CRC recommendation.

##### **Licensing Laws and Rules re-write update**

Spaht reported that the Laws & Rules Committee had met before the board meeting to consider possible changes to the licensure sections of the Architect Licensing Law. The primary sections considered were R.S. 37:141 and R.S. 37:145-151. The Committee felt that good progress had been made, and it would now focus upon the rules related to these statutes. The work of the Committee will be presented to the board at some later time. The Committee still has much work to do.

#### **Complaint Review Committee Report**

Brossett and Owens presented the report of the Complaint Review Committee (“CRC”) consisting of Singh, Kobila, and Brossett.

**Case #2022-13** - Owens reported on a case involving a professional architectural corporation which practiced and/or offered to practice architecture in Louisiana with an expired certificate of authority. The Respondent signed and returned the proposed consent order offered by the CRC. The proposed consent order contained the following sanctions:

1. Respondent to pay a fine of \$1,500 and costs of \$658.28;
2. Publication of this disciplinary action on the Board’s website and a summary of this matter printed in the Board’s newsletter, both identifying Respondent by name, and
3. Reporting this matter to NCARB Disciplinary Database identifying Respondent by name.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Cardone, seconded by Mr. Holly, with the CRC members abstaining, to accept the consent order as presented.

After the motion passed, the Respondent was identified as Dean Hotard & Associates. P.A.C.

**Case #2022-20** - Owens reported on a case involving an architect who practiced and/or offered to practice architecture in Louisiana with an expired license. The respondent signed and returned the proposed consent order offered by the CRC. The proposed consent order contained the following sanctions:

1. Respondent to pay a fine of \$3,000 and costs of \$455.81;
2. Publication of this disciplinary action on the Board’s website and a summary of this matter printed in the Board’s newsletter, both identifying Respondent by name, and
3. Reporting this matter to NCARB Disciplinary Database identifying Respondent by name.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Holly, seconded by Cardone, with the CRC members abstaining, to accept the consent order as presented.

After the motion passed, the Respondent was identified as Marc A. Robert.

Owens provided an update on current enforcement statistics noting that there were 21 open cases, 21 cases closed since the December meeting, 22 cases opened since the December meeting, 57 pending cases, and 12 letters of caution issued since the December meeting.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Ms. Kobila, seconded by Mr. Singh, to approve the list of licenses and certificates issued for the period December 7, 2022, through May 16, 2023.

Ducote reported on the end of April 2023 data provided by NCARB on Louisiana architectural candidates and licensees:

Stewart reported on the NCARB Licensing Advisor boot camp, which she attended in Orlando, FL, in early February.

#### Executive Director's Report

##### LSBAE Laws & Rules Quiz

Ducote gave an update on developing the LSBAE Laws & Rules quiz and the AIA HSW approval process. He stated that AIA National would not approve the quiz for 1 HSW as it is not considered a "Structured Educational Activity" and fails to meet the criteria for AIA HSW credit (self-reported or otherwise). Ducote mentioned that LSBAE has the authority to approve the laws and rules quiz for 1 HSW Continuing Education hour.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Holly, seconded by Mr. Cardone, to approve the LSBAE laws and rules quiz for 1 Continuing Education Hour of HSW credit.

##### 2023 Continuing Education pre-audit update

Ducote gave an update on reviewing and approving the contract with CE Broker to have them facilitate the CE audit for the next three years. He notified the board that the 2022 CY audit would take place in the fall of 2023, and next year's audit would resume being held in the spring.

##### April 2023 Financial Statement

Ducote reported on the end of April financial numbers. Income was 105% of the FY23 budgeted amount, with the bulk of income coming from the individual renewal cycle, which began November 1<sup>st</sup>. He noted that any remaining income earned would come through initial, reciprocal, and reinstatement architect license applications and initial and reinstatement firm certificate applications. Firm renewals began on May 1<sup>st</sup>; however, that revenue is earmarked for the 2024 fiscal year. Expenses are 68% of the FY23 budget, with approximately one month remaining in the fiscal year.

##### CD investment

Ducote reported that the board's CD held at Capital One Bank will not be renewed, and the funds will be returned to the board at the end of June.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Brossett, seconded by Mr. Holly, to deposit the returned CD into the checking account and to begin implementing a CD laddering investment strategy with the funds being invested in local Louisiana-based banks and credit unions where possible.

#### Stolen Mail Update

Ducote reported on the stolen check and gave a recap on what had happened for the benefit of Mr. Elberson. He stated that he is still waiting for reimbursement of the stolen funds.

#### Telework Metrics

Ducote reported on staff telework metrics.

#### Discussion Items

##### 2024 Architecture Education Research Fund application review

Ducote gave an update on the work involved in preparing the FY24 AERF announcement. Blich then gave an overview of the program for Mr. Elberson's benefit. Ducote stated that invitations had been forwarded to all four NAAB-accredited architecture schools, but Louisiana Tech University was the only one that applied for the FY24 award.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Brossett, seconded by Mr. Holly, to distribute \$15,000 in funds from the AERF to Louisiana Tech University for a consultancy program wherein a practicing façade consultant and a mechanical engineer will serve as consultants to the comprehensive design studio for the upcoming academic year.

The Board also unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Brossett, seconded by Mr. Holly, to distribute up to \$5,000 in additional funds for the reimbursement of the travel expenses of two individuals from the university to attend and present at the Region 3 Educator Conference and the NCARB Annual Business Meeting or NCARB Regional Summit meeting in 2025. Individuals attending and presenting will be reimbursed their travel expenses in accordance with the Division of Administration's Louisiana Travel Policy 2023-2024 set forth in PPM No. 49.

Mr. Brossett exited the meeting at 2:20 p.m.

##### LSBAE board self-evaluation survey

Ducote discussed the self-evaluation survey discussed at last year's strategic planning session. Mary deSousa has forwarded a copy of the annual self-evaluation survey that the NCARB board does. Ducote stated that he would reformat and send it to the board members to take. The results will be discussed at the July meeting.

##### NCARB Annual Business Meeting Discussion


Ducote reported that he was appointed for a second term on the Member Board Executives Committee. Blich led the discussion on the candidates in the contested elections and the resolutions to be voted on at the meeting. Ducote then displayed a chart showing the board members and staff members and their various amounts of funding from NCARB and discussed travel arrangements for the unfunded members and staff.

The Board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Holly, seconded by Mr. Cardone, to approve travel funds to the NCARB Annual Business Meeting in Tampa, FL, on June 15-17, 2023, for the unfunded board members, the Deputy Director, and for the unfunded portion of President Blich's expenses not covered by NCARB.

#### Adjournment

The board unanimously approved the motion by Mr. Holly, seconded by Mr. Cardone, to adjourn the meeting.
