REPORT OF COMPLIANCE DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NIGHTINGALE John Becknell reported that project nightingale was a FBI operation that investigated the distribution of over 7,600 fraudulent nursing diplomas and transcripts through the state of Florida. FBI informants were able to secure a list of all individuals who were issued fraudulent diplomas and transcripts. NCSBN matched this list with the national databank in each state so that alerts would be generated for these individuals. Mr. Becknell reported that from this list, there were about 15 individuals listed in Louisiana, none of whom were working or had obtained a license to work in the state. The lists are constantly being updated by the FBI and monitored by board staff.

NCSBN DISCIPLINE CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

John Becknell reported on NCSBN's recent discipline case management conference held in May. The conference topic was reimagining discipline, which discussed the psychiatry involved when nurses are facing discipline and how we can better protect the public by encouraging that nurse to comply with their board orders with monitoring and drug testing.

MULTISTATE LICENSE DISCIPLINE AUDIT

John Becknell reported that when a nurse has disciplinary action on their single state license, they are ineligible for a multistate license in another jurisdiction. It was discovered that nurses in Louisiana who possess single state licenses with disciplinary action were obtaining multi state licenses in other states, allowing them the ability to continue working in Louisiana. NCSBN is aware of this and is in the process of developing an audit tool to assist in reporting these cases to the appropriate state boards for investigation of improper issuance of multistate licenses.

INITIATIVES

John Becknell reported that the compliance staff will be meeting to discuss how improvements can be made to stay in line with best practices. Additionally, moving forward disciplinary cases will be considered for a consent order instead of a formal hearing when appropriate.

Mr. Becknell informed the board that LSBPNE is still working towards establishing credit card payments for disciplinary fines and fees.

REPORT OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

PN PROGRAM – STATUS OF ALL PN SCHOOLS

Christina Costanza presented a summary status of all practical nursing programs, reporting on current cohorts, enrollment numbers, graduating classes, and the number of students that have successfully completed the program from each campus. As of June 28, 2023, there are currently 51 schools with 114 ongoing classes and 1581 enrolled students.

NCLEX-PN ™

Cristina Costanza presented information concerning the NCLEX-PN TM pass rates for all Louisiana writers and repeat candidates for 2021, 2022, and 1/1/2023 – 6/14/2023.

The pass rate for Louisiana in 2021 was 82.63%, with a national average of 79.6%; 2022 pass rate was 80.04% with a national average of 79.93%. Year to date, NCLEX-PN pass rate for Louisiana is 87.55%; however, since the inception of the next generation NCLEX-PN test that began April 1, 2023, the pass rate for Louisiana has increased to 94.35%. No action was needed or taken.

2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

John Becknell reported on two bills from the 2023 legislative session.

Senate Bill 20 allows licensed practical nurses scholarship opportunities, from private hospitals as well as public hospitals, in exchange for signing a contract to practice nursing or an allied health profession in the facility once licensed. Each scholarship shall be awarded for the purpose of defraying the costs of tuition, fees, and other related expenses and cost for attendance at nursing or allied health school.

House Bill 320 would allow graduates of registered nursing programs approved by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing the ability to apply for and take the NCLEX-PN. The application process for taking the NCLEX-PN would remain the same for both practical nurses as well as registered nurses.
