1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Red River Waterway Commission was called to order by Chair Designee, Troy Roussell, in the Activity Center of the Red River Waterway Commission Grand Ecore RV Park located at 1071 Tauzin Island Road in Natchitoches, Louisiana.

By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Fletcher, the minutes of the August 19, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved by roll call vote.

- 1. <u>Consideration of Award of Colfax Activity Center Porch Addition Bids/RRWC Project No. 20-05:</u> By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Clark, the Commission unanimously approved by roll call vote award of bid to Martin Metal Construction in the amount of \$59,760.00 (base bid plus alternate 1) along with a corresponding budget amendment increase to \$70,000.00.

Consideration of Authority to Advertise for Public Bid Lease/Kateland Realignment/Tracts 1, 3, 5 & 7/100 Acres: By motion of Commissioner Deville, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved by roll call vote authorizing staff to advertise for public bid lease the property described as being Kateland Realignment, tracts 1, 3, 5 & 7, consisting of 100 acres at a minimum bid price of \$20.00 per acre.

1. Recreation Area Status Report

Mr. Mike Boydstun highlighted the prepared report provided in the meeting packet, noting that there had been 151,000 visitors to the District recreation areas during the month of August 2020. Updated maintenance items include, but not limited to:

- Dredging Oxbows and backwater areas
- Dredging from Alexandria to Shreveport is mostly completed. Currently finishing up at the Stoner Avenue location
- Cutterhead dredge is in Pool 5
- Hurricane Laura storm cleanup has been taking place at all 19 sites. Grant parish area, specifically the Boyce area required extensive cleanup
- Ft. Buhlow recreation area is still without power. Awaiting a bid from an electrical contractor
- d) Ports
- 1. <u>Consideration of Approval of Settlement Documents/Cool Planet:</u> By motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Crutchfield, the Commission unanimously approved by roll call vote the presented Settlement Agreement with Cool Planet.

- Caddo-Bossier Port is seeing increase in usage due to barging of steel

- A Cooperative Endeavor Agreement is in process with the City of Natchitoches and the Natchitoches Convention & Visitors Bureau with the Red River Waterway Commission sponsoring a National Catfish Tournament
