MINUTES OF THE RED RIVER WATERWAY COMMISSION MEETING OCTOBER 21, 2020 10:00 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Red River Waterway Commission was called to order by Chair Designee, Troy Roussell, in the Activity Center of the Red River Waterway Commission Grand Ecore RV Park located at 1071 Tauzin Island Road in Natchitoches, Louisiana.

4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

By motion of Commissioner Crutchfield, seconded by Commissioner Latter, the Commission unanimously approved, by roll call vote, amending the agenda to reflect the following in the Recreation Committee Report: Consideration of Red River Levee Bicycle Trail. Comments from the public were called for, however, none were offered.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

By motion of Commissioner Simpson, seconded by Commissioner Deville, the minutes of the September 16, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved by roll call vote.

6. TREASURER'S REPORT

By motion of Commissioner Crutchfield, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the Expenditures, Financial Statements, Investment Reports, & Fund Balance Report for the month of September 2020 were unanimously approved by roll call

7. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a) Contracts
- 1. Consideration of Approval of 2021 Contracts List: By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Goudeau, the Commission unanimously approved the 2021 contracts list by roll call vote.
- b) Land Management, Legal Affairs & Affirmative Action
- Consideration of Award of Public Bid Lease/Kateland Realignment/Parts of Tracts 1, 3, 5 & 7/100 Acres: By motion of Commissioner Deville, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved by roll call vote award of bid to Mr. Andre Martin for \$10,000.00 (\$20.00 per acre annually) for the 5-year lease term.
- 2. <u>Consideration of Request to Advertise for Public Bid Lease/St. Maurice Cut-Off/Part of Tract 2/23.6 Acres</u>: By motion of Commissioner Deville, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the Commission unanimously approved by roll call vote authorizing staff to advertise the property for public bid lease with a minimum bid price of \$25.00 per acre and stipulation prohibiting rifle hunting.

- Consideration of Approval of Red River Levee Bicycle Trail: By motion of Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Fleming, the Commission unanimously approved approved by roll call vote directing interested parties to meet with Levee Boards and all other involved entities for approvals and then re-address the request with the Red River Waterway Commission. This action confirmed the direction provided by the Commission in April 2018.

2. Recreation Area Status Report

Mr. Mike Boydstun highlighted the prepared report provided in the meeting packet, noting that there had been 149,000 visitors to the District recreation areas during the month of September 2020. Updated maintenance items include, but not limited to:

- Stoner barge has been removed
- Storm cleanup from Hurricane Laura has been completed
- Grand Ecore RV Park reservations are increasing and will typically do so through the holiday season
- Completed spraying 100 acres of Giant Salvinia in backwaters
- Cross Country meet took place at the Ft. Buhlow Recreation area
- Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries has begun releasing Florida Bass and Tiger Bass into specific pools of the Red River
- d) **Ports** Representatives of the Natchitoches, Red River, Caddo-Bossier, and Central Louisiana Regional Ports updated the Ports Committee on Port activities and development.

- 1. Consideration of Approval of Cooperative Endeavor Agreement/City of Natchitoches and Natchitoches Convention

 Visitors Bureau/KingKat National Championship: By motion of Commissioner Fletcher, seconded by

 Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved, by roll call vote, the cooperative endeavor agreement with the City of Natchitoches and the Natchitoches Convention Visitors Bureau for the upcoming KingKat National Championship
- 2. <u>Consideration of Approval/Public Memorial Request</u>: By motion of Commissioner Fletcher, seconded by Commissioner Crutchfield, the Commission unanimously approved, by roll call vote, tabeling the request and instructed staff to bring back options for a memorial policy.
