Comments from Executive Director  a. CARF survey review	Brad Farmer provided a summary decision to the board from CARF detailing our three-year accreditation, and offered an electronic copy of the entire accreditation report, which included 20 recommendations. Brad reported that his accreditation team meets next week to begin the Quality Improvement Plan for addressing recommendations over the coming 3 years.	
b. LANO meeting reminder	Brad offered reminder of the LANO (Louisiana Association of Nonprofit Organizations) meeting hosted by AAHSD next Tuesday, June 25. Dr. Emily Sandoz commented on the importance of having events at AAHSD, and ED echoed the intention to continue to be involved in this way.	
c. New prevention program	Brad also shared that Evangeline Parish initiated collaboration with AAHSD to monitor a new contract. They were contacted by the Pax Institute (www.paxis.org) who is beginning programming in the Evangeline Parish school system via funding by OBH to	

support teachers and other staff. Dr. Sandoz voiced support regarding the Pax program's empirical support and the integrity of the directors. Several board members expressed interest in the programming and in helping the project to be successful.

Brad described another new program Louisiana is getting involved in called Shatterproof, which aims to create a shared language regarding addiction risk factors, treatment, etc. The Board expressed support for this initiative. Brad mentioned representing the LGE's on the state's Advisory Council.

Brad also shared strategy regarding outreach and advertising. Shared a two page spread in local periodicals and described quarterly campaigns of this type. Also shared a new contract with channel 15, which will allow for improved community connections through morning show visits, community event announcements, etc. Carol suggested that including more details around services in a brochure or other written materials. Brad described plan to update the brochures to offer an overall brochure along with program. Dr. Emily Sandoz suggested rotating content and speakers for visits regularly, and updating the website with the new copy from the brochures.

Brad shared the Lifestyle magazine where the AAHSD's New Iberia Clinic was featured with general information.
