Review the agenda for the 2016 LSWA workshops for approval of hours.

Mr. Mollere, will you be making the presentation?

MR. MOLLERE:

Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Members of the Board, it's a pleasure to be before you this morning. We have, I think, a copy presented to you for the two workshops that we're proposing in Marksville on July 19th and 20th and in Shreveport on October 25th and 26th. As you can see, the proposed agenda leans more toward the C&D topics this time, but the ten hours that we are proposing we think we have a pretty good program. We have, again, one of the areas, role-playing, which has been very, very familiar — very popular in the past.

1	Ms. Swacker has agreed to do that. We'll
2	also have the Mr. Majors from DEQ come
3	on the second day and present a topic on
4	inspections. And then, the last thing
5	that we have is something that we felt was
6	very important. On the waste tire program
7	we're proposing a panel with a regulator
8	and several processors, perhaps, that will
9	actually talk about what's happening to
10	the tire program in the state. We think
11	that that's very relevant at this time.
12	But I would hope that the Board would
13	find this acceptable and you would grant
14	the ten hours that we are asking for.
15	MR. BARBER:
16	I offer a motion we approve it.
17	MR. BONVILLAIN:
18	Okay. A motion by Mr. Barber.
19	MS. TOWNSEL:
20	Second.
21	MR. WYNN:
22	Second.
23	MR. BONVILLAIN:
24	You can't second.

3	MR. BONVILLAIN:
4	Okay. At this point all we're doing
5	is approving the application and then
6	we'll get to the test part later when we
7	actually issue the certificates.
8	Okay. Next we have Marcus Breaux for
9	a Landfill Level B.
10	Next, James Chaney, C&D, Level A.
11	Marcus Chauvin for a
12	MS. BORDELON:
13	Transfer Station, Level A.
14	MR. BONVILLAIN:
15	Transfer Station, Level A. Here it
16	is. Okay. Transfer Station, Level A.
17	Okay. You've got Davis and Gonzalez,
18	should we put those off until
19	MS. BORDELON:
20	Well, no, because they were well,
21	they were they were applying for
22	regular according to his letter.
23	MR. WYNN:
24	Neither one of them has enough hours.
25	MR. BONVILLAIN:

Okay. Let's take one at a time,
then.
Matthew Davis applying for
Incinerator, Level B.
MR. BARBER:
Well, they're trying to get his work
at the fire department to classify as
experience, and it doesn't. We all know
that. And, of course, the short time that
he's been with the company actually doing
the operation has only been since
November. So, he certainly doesn't have
the
MS. BORDELON:
Well, he's got work at trackhoe
and bulldozer work at another position
from 2007 to 2009.
MR. BARBER:
But that wasn't that says well
service.
MR. BONVILLAIN:
I think that's the type of experience
if he was applying for landfill or a
C&D

MR. WILLIAMS:

Right.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

-- would be properly applied, but I can't see where that would be applied for an incinerator.

MS. BORDELON:

Well, I thought the construction -the substitution just simply said
construction experience. I could be
wrong.

Level B operator experience
requirements: A minimum of two years of
experience as described in blah, blah,
blah in the field of solid waste
management. A minimum of one year in the
field of solid waste management or two
years as a supervisor in a construction
field relating to the use of heavy
equipment, good drainage practice, and
other skills to ensure proper operation of
a solid waste processing or disposal
facility.

MR. WYNN:

That is a situation where, you know, they might be able to pass with a -- with

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1	that type of experience with the equipment
2	but that here we go again. I'm like
3	Gary, that does not have anything to do
4	with that type of work.
5	MR. FOURRIER:
6	Well, he still has to have one year
7	experience as a Level B and construction,
8	so he doesn't have the one year.
9	MS. BORDELON:
10	Right.
11	MR. BONVILLAIN:
12	Yeah. He doesn't have the one year
13	either.
14	MR. FOURRIER:
15	It says a Level B. And they're
16	trying to replace a conditional with a
17	conditional.
18	MR. BONVILLAIN:
19	Well, we'll address that when we get
20	to conditional certificates, but this is
21	whether or not we approve the application
22	for a regular certificate.
23	MR. WYNN:
24	I can't see it.

5	I offer a motion to deny it.

12	application for Matthew Davis for a
13	landfill I mean, Incinerator, Level B,

19	denied?
20	MR. BONVILLAIN:
21	Do what?

23	And when you tell him, you'll explain

5	Yeah, that he doesn't meet the
6	experience requirement.

13	Same situation.
14	MR. BARBER:
15	as before.
16	I offer a motion to deny it.
17	MR. BONVILLAIN:
18	Okay. A motion by Mr. Barber.
19	Any second?
20	MR. FOURRIER:
21	I second.

23	Second by Mr. Fourrier that the
24	application for Salvador Gonzalez for a
25	Level B Incinerator be denied.

1	Any objections to the motion?
2	Hearing none, the motion passes.
3	Okay. Next we have Alfredo

5	Next, Daniel Hylton, Landfill, Level
6	Α.
7	Clinton Johnson, Separation, Level B
8	MR. BARBER:
9	He will be it looks to me like he
10	will be eligible on 4/14 for a regular
11	certification. Am I looking at that
12	right?
13	MS. BORDELON:
14	Uh-huh (yes).
15	MR. BARBER:
16	So, I think being that's the case I
17	would offer a motion that
18	MR. BONVILLAIN:
19	Upon the completion of
20	MR. BARBER:
21	upon that date, on 4/14 of 2006
22	that he be approved for his regular
23	certification.
24	MR. BONVILLAIN:
25	Okay.

1	MR. WYNN:
2	Second that motion.
3	MR. BONVILLAIN:
4	Got a motion by Mr. Barber.

8	seconded by Mr. Wynn that

10	effective 4/14/16.
11	Any objections to the motion?
12	Motion carries.
13	Next, John Mickey, Transfer Station,
14	Level A.
15	MR. BARBER:
16	Who?
17	MS. BORDELON:
18	John Mickey.
19	MR. BONVILLAIN:
20	John Mickey. If you've got an
21	e-mail, his was the one that was
22	MS. BORDELON:
23	Yeah, that was one of the late ones.
24	MR. BONVILLAIN:
25	turned around.

1	MS. BORDELON:
2	Yeah, that was the one that was
3	sideways.
4	MR. BARBER:
5	I must have not had oh
6	MR. BONVILLAIN:
7	Suzanne sent that one
8	MR. BARBER:
9	Yeah.
10	MR. BONVILLAIN:
11	a day or two late.
12	MR. BARBER:
13	I had trouble with that one. I do
14	have it somewhere.
15	MS. BORDELON:
16	I made it bigger, because I couldn't
17	read it. But I did get the original.
18	MR. BARBER:
19	That looks good to me.
20	MS. BORDELON:
21	He used to have a Landfill, Level A
22	certification years ago.
23	MR. BONVILLAIN:
24	Okay. Everybody okay with that?
25	MR. BARBER:

Uh-huh (yes). 1 2 MR. BONVILLAIN: Next is Joshua Morris, Separation, 3 Level B. 5 MR. BARBER: 6 I'm a little confused. I think I'm 7 okay with it, but I'm a little confused. 8 He puts in here that he has worked from 9 October of 2011 to present at a scrap 10 metal facility and then he's also worked at a separation facility, it looks like 11 12 for the same period of time. 13 MR. WYNN: 14 Southern Disposable. 15 MS. BORDELON: He's working a hundred hours a week. 16 17 MR. WYNN: Troy, on this situation, I know 18 this -- the one -- the Johnson and Morris 19 20 both, they are half-brothers and they both 21 own Southern Disposal, and they are 22 also -- have that metal operation. 23 MR. BARBER: 24 So, you're satisfied with their experience?

3	MR. BARBER:
4	Okay. I'm good.
5	MR. BONVILLAIN:
6	I do have one thing. He did not sign
7	his application.
8	MS. BORDELON:
9	Yeah, Mia just brought that up, too.
10	MR. BONVILLAIN:
11	Okay. So you'll make sure that you
12	get the signature on that?
13	MS. BORDELON:
14	Uh-huh (yes).
15	MR. BONVILLAIN:
16	Okay.
17	MR. WYNN:
18	I make a motion well, nevermind,
19	we can't do that now.
20	MS. BORDELON:
21	Yeah, this guy's had a conditional
22	for two years, now, too.
23	MR. BONVILLAIN:
24	Okay. Next is John Roofner, C&D,
25	Level B.

1	MR. WYNN:
2	When did how long of a time did
3	elapse for this, Suzanne?
4	MR. WILLIAMS:
5	For his application?
6	MR. WYNN:
7	Yeah.
8	MR. BONVILLAIN:
9	July 15.
10	MR. LAGRANGE:
11	Is he also applying for a Separation,
12	Level B?
13	MS. BORDELON:
14	No. '
15	MR. LAGRANGE:
16	He's not?
17	MR. BONVILLAIN:
18	No.
19	MS. BORDELON:
20	No.
21	MR. BARBER:
22	It looks like it was checked off,
23	that's why.
24	MS. BORDELON:
25	Yeah, I tried to white them out. He

3		Yeah. I mean, he's had a Level B
4	t	that expired, so I mean, he meets all the
5	1	requirements.
6		Next Rodley Jude Roy, Landfill, Level

10	<u>1</u>	4S. BORDELON:
11		He did retest.
12	<u>1</u>	MR. WYNN:
13		And he passed?

17		Okay.
18	<u>1</u>	AR. BONVILLAIN:
19		Okay. Rodley Roy, Landfill, Level B.
20		Heather Rene Schamerhorn, C&D, Level

23		I got a question here. I think I'm
24		okay with it, but when we talk about
25		experience, is this is there anywhere

1	that would indicate that it has to be
2	full-time experience? It looks like that
3	she only works 20 hours a week.
4	MR. WYNN:
5	They probably, since they it's a
6	family-owned business, they probably work
7	more than what they're just putting down.
8	And they grew up in the business.
9	MS. BORDELON:
10	Four years of 20 hours a week.
11	MR. BONVILLAIN:
12	Yeah, it's she's got four years of
13	20 hours a week, so that's equivalent to
14	two years at 40 hours a week. So, yeah.
15	MR. BARBER:
16	I guess if you do the math, that's
17	okay.
18	MR. WILLIAMS:
19	That's the new math.
20	MR. LAGRANGE:
21	No, that's old math.
22	MR. BONVILLAIN:
23	Thank you for pointing that out,
24	Suzanne.
25	Next is Tammy Schamerhorn, C&D, Level

1	B. And pretty much more of the same.
2	MR. WILLIAMS:
3	Same.
4	MR. BONVILLAIN:
5	Twenty-five hours a week for a little
6	bit longer period of time.
7	Next, Joshua Sturgeon, C&D, Level B.
8	Travis Scott, C&D, Level A.
9	MR. WYNN:
10	He took the test?
11	MS. BORDELON:
12	He did.
13	MR. WYNN:
14	Okay.
15	MS. BORDELON:
16	And he passed.
17	MR. BONVILLAIN:
18	Kristal Smith, Landfill, Level B.
19	MR. BARBER:
20	This is another one of those
21	MR. WYNN:
22	I thought this was a conditional?
23	MR. BARBER:
24	Well, as of
25	MR. WYNN:

1	She's got conditional marked in the
2	block.
3	MR. BONVILLAIN:
4	Well, she's got both of them.
5	MS. BORDELON:
6	She did well, yeah, she does. She
7	has she's had a conditional, she's
8	applying for a regular now.
9	MR. LAGRANGE:
10	As of five
11	MS. BORDELON:
12	What's the date? Yeah.
13	MR. BARBER:
14	As of 5/3/16 she will be eligible for
15	a regular certification, so
16	MS. BORDELON:
17	I did notify her of the date and told
18	her that it would be possible that it
19	would not be issued until May.
20	MR. BARBER:
21	And I will offer a motion that as of
22	May 3, 2016 that we issue her a regular
23	certification.
24	MR. BONVILLAIN:
25	Okay. Motion by Mr. Barber.

1	MR. WILLIAMS:
2	Second.
3	MR. BONVILLAIN:
4	Seconded by Mr. Williams.
5	Any objection to the motion?
6	Hearing none, the motion passes.
7	Review requests for conditional
8	certification.
9	MR. LAGRANGE:
10	Excuse me, Mr. Chairman, do you need
11	a motion to approve all the rest of the
12	applications regulars?
13	MR. BONVILLAIN:
14	Not yet, we're going to issue them
15	later it's later on in the agenda that
16	we issue oh, okay. I'm sorry. You're
17	right. You're right.
18	Yeah, do I have a motion
19	MR. LAGRANGE:
20	I'll make that motion.
21	MR. BARBER:
22	(INDICATING)
23	MR. BONVILLAIN:
24	Okay. We have a motion from
25	Mr. Lagrange, and second from Mr. Barber

2	applications do I need to name them -
3	that we did not act on separately in the
4	list.
5	Any objection to the motion?
6	Hearing none, the motion carries.
7	Okay. Review requests for
8	conditional certification.
9	MS. BORDELON:

14	We've got some conditional renewals
15	MS. BORDELON:
16	They're all extensions.

18	All right. Okay. The two we have,
19	then, are those two from Stericycle.
20	MR. LAGRANGE:
21	Well, excuse me
22	MR. BONVILLAIN:
23	Which is Matthew Davis and Salvador
24	Gonzalez.
25	MS. BORDELON:

2	MR. BARBER:
3	What were you saying about these?
4	MR. BONVILLAIN:
5	Those are extensions of conditionals.
6	MR. LAGRANGE:
7	Okay. So we don't have to review
8	them.
9	MS. BORDELON:
10	We are. It's next on the agenda.
11	MR. BONVILLAIN:
12	We'll get to that later, but first we
13	have a request for conditionals from those
14	two from Stericycle that we did not
15	approve their regular application.
16	MR. LAGRANGE:
17	Okay.
18	MR. BONVILLAIN:
19	Okay. And that is Matthew Davis
20	first.
21	MR. BARBER:
22	Well, I guess, for the record,
23	everybody knows where I stand on this. I
24	have a problem granting a conditional that
25	is replacing a conditional.

1	MR. BONVILLAIN:
2	Would you like to make a motion to
3	deny the issuance of the conditional?
4	MR. BARBER:
5	Let's see if there's any more
6	discussion.
7	MR. WILLIAMS:
8	How many regulars do they have?
9	MS. BORDELON:
10	I don't have it in front of me, but
11	if I'm not mistaken I think we issued them
12	three regulars.
13	MR. WILLIAMS:
14	Okay.
15	MR. LAGRANGE:
16	For this location?
17	MS. BORDELON:
18	For that location. We've issued, I
19	think, three regulars and we originally
20	had issued eight conditionals. We've
21	replaced some of those conditionals
22	already with conditionals.
23	MR. WYNN:
24	Do you know what meeting that was
25	when we first issued the conditions?

1	MS. BORDELON:
2	It was in Shreveport last year.
3	MR. WILLIAMS:
4	It was in Shreveport, I remember
5	that.
6	MS. BORDELON:
7	Yeah.
8	MR. LAGRANGE:
9	So, we've kind of set a precedent by
10	issuing replacing conditionals with
11	conditionals, you said a couple already.
12	MS. BORDELON:
13	Uh-huh (yes).
14	MR. LAGRANGE:
15	Of those eight original
16	conditionals
17	MS. BORDELON:
18	There are probably only four of those
19	original eight still there.
20	MR. LAGRANGE:
21	And these applications are would
22	replace
23	MS. BORDELON:
24	Two of the original eight.
25	MR. LAGRANGE:

1	And you said we have approved some
2	replacements already?
3	MS. BORDELON:
4	Uh-huh (yes).
5	MR. BONVILLAIN:
6	At previous meetings we have approved
7	to replace a conditional with a
8	conditional.
9	MS. BORDELON:
10	And I think it's on the
11	applications on one of the
12	applications. I think it's Dustin
13	Valentine is one that we actually replaced
14	a conditional with Dustin Valentine and
15	now Dustin Valentine is also has left.
16	MR. LAGRANGE:
17	All right. This on Davis'
18	application he says he is replacing
19	Charles Smith.
20	MS. BORDELON:
21	I think he was an original one. Does
22	the other say Dustin Valentine?
23	MR. LAGRANGE:
24	Yes. Dustin.
25	MS RODDELON.

1	Yeah. And Dustin Valentine, we just
2	issued his in I believe in October. He
3	was Dustin replaced another conditional
4	and now he's gone.
5	MR. BARBER:
6	Well, he says in his narrative here
7	that these individuals will be replacing
8	two conditional employees who are no
9	longer with the company. So, we know
10	that. And, you know, I feel like they're
11	taking advantage of this Board by just
12	continuing this thing. This could go on
13	forever. I think they need some regular
14	certifications.
15	MR. WYNN:
16	I also agree with
17	MR. WILLIAMS:
18	I agree with it.
19	MR. WYNN:
20	I agree with that.
21	MR. WILLIAMS:
22	I agree with you.
23	MR. WYNN:
24	Because they are looking for the
25	Board to keep them in compliance.

1	MR. BARBER:
2	Uh-huh (yes).
3	MR. WYNN:
4	And it's not the Board's policy to
5	keep them in compliance.
6	MR. BARBER:
7	Absolutely.
8	MR. WILLIAMS:
9	You know, I was in favor of granting
LO	the conditionals initially.
11	MR. WYNN:
12	I was, too, because it was a startup
١3	operation.
l 4	MR. WILLIAMS:
15	Exactly. Exactly. But now, you
۱6	know, at some point
l.7	MR. WYNN:
L8	Right.
۱9	MR. WILLIAMS:
20	in my opinion we have to draw the
21	line.
22	MR. LAGRANGE:
23	Right. But you also need to consider
24	that we have already approved some
25	conditionals replacing conditionals since

1	the original
2	MR. WILLIAMS:
3	Yeah.
4	MR. LAGRANGE:
5	times.
6	MR. WILLIAMS:
7	I understand what you're saying, but
8	we're not
9	MR. BONVILLAIN:
10	That doesn't bind us for any
11	future
12	MR. WILLIAMS:
13	No. I think we have to look at each
14	one as an individual situation. And, like
15	I said, I was originally for, and I voted
16	to grant the eight conditionals, but now,
1,7	to me, I think it's just, you know, I find
18	myself having to agree with Troy.
19	MR. WYNN:
20	You would think that
21	MS. BORDELON:
22	Is that on the record?
23	MR. WILLIAMS:
24	I couldn't resist that, Troy.
25	MR. BARBER:

1 Thank you, Fred. MR. WILLIAMS: 2 3 No problem. 4 MR. WYNN: I would say in this period of time 5 you would think they had enough time to go 6 7 out and find B Levels in fields, not only from Louisiana, but also from all across 8 9 America. 10 MR. 5	Due to an unintended oversight, the
6	application for renewal of a solid waste
7	operator could not be submitted to the
8	Louisiana Board of Certification and
9	Training for Solid Waste Operators during
10	the timeframe allowed under LAC 46:23.9
11	23.B. Through this letter I herein
12	petition the Board of Certification and
13	Training for Solid Waste Operators for
. 14	granting a one-time exemption from the
15	reference regulation and allowing late
16	recertification of my solid waste
17	operator's certificate for the next
18	four-year term. This one-time exemption
19	is sought due to the following
20	justification as presented below. Number
21	one, this was an unintended oversight on
22	my part. Number two, there's been no
23	disruption of work performed by me for
24	which the solid waste operator certificate
25	was issued. I remained employed by AAT

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during the last four years, and have been responsible for oversight of solid waste management activities currently being performed at the facility. Number three, I have met the requirement of 40 hours of contact training continuing education requirement for the purpose of recertification of my solid waste certificate, copies enclosed. Number four, since I have been attending solid waste workshops each year and earning ten hours of contact training continuing education credit each year, I am eligible for solid waste management requirements. No significant impact on the public health, safety, and welfare in the environment is anticipated from this request for late recertification. Number five, retaking the test will place additional financial burden on me as the oil recycling industry is already going through tough economic times. A complete solid waste operator recertification application along with the late fee of \$200 is enclosed with this submittal.

24	MR. LAGRANGE:

also there is the -- in our regs the exemption section, and I think that's where he got some of his verbiage. It says, the Board may provide exemptions from these regulations or any portion thereof when petitions for such are deemed to result in no significant impact on the public, health, safety, and welfare of the environment.

Just for the Board's benefit.

MS. BORDELON:

It appears he's only been -- for four years, because this certificate was issued in '11.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

We had one of the applications we proved earlier today, Mr. Hylton, has been certified and his certification expired.

He came and he retested.

And, for my personal point of view, you know, he just didn't take care of business. I mean, if this would have been a situation where he'd been hospitalized or out of action or something like that and the timeframe had passed, I might be

1	amenable to it, but as far as I'm
2	concerned he just didn't take care of his
3	business.
4	But, up to the Board. What do you
5	want to do?
6	MR. WYNN:
7	Make a motion he's going to have to

What are your thoughts?

MS. BORDELON:

I don't know what else to do. We talked about this about a year ago, and we handed out nomination forms at the workshops to try to get them out there.

But maybe that was too soon. We normally -- I normally send out the

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nomination forms late December.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

And we did address it at the workshops, you know.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

I made the announcement, I know for sure, asking them to please --

MS. BORDELON:

I've even changed my application to include their e-mail address so that I can try to get more emails from the individual operators or applicants so that when I send those out I have more e-mail addresses. Because if you send it to just the facility owner, you know, operator -- main operator, they're not -- half the time they don't distribute them to their -- to the rest of their operators.

MR. BARBER:

Well, I have an idea. I know we've always left it open to all operators to nominate whoever they wanted to, but what if at our two workshops we have more than

1	just an announcement, have a little
2	session on this and at the workshops let
3	the people that are attending that
4	particular workshop nominate two B Level
5	and to A Level from among that group at
6	each one of the two workshops. And then
7	if anybody else wants to nominate through
8	the course of the year from their facility
9	or whatever, but at least that way you
10	would have some participation, people
11	would be aware and they would have we
12	would have some nominations way in advance
13	of the conference.
14	MR. BONVILLAIN:
15	And we wouldn't have to limit it to
16	two. I mean, we
17	MR. WILLIAMS:

20	Huh-uh (no). Yeah.

22	Yeah, I mean, we could have as many
23	as you wanted.
24	MS. BORDELON:

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Well, like I said, and that's --

2	At least have an A and a B.
3	MR. BONVILLAIN:
4	Yeah.
5	MS. BORDELON:
6	Yeah, that's a good point, because at
7	the other workshop we just handed out the
8	forms, but if we told them, fill them out
9.	before you leave
10	MR. BARBER:
11	Uh-huh (yes).
12	MS. BORDELON:
13	and turn them in
14	MR. WILLIAMS:
15	Yeah.
16	MS. BORDELON:
17	Maybe.
18	MR. BONVILLAIN:
19	Yeah, and, you know, and they may not
20	have all the information, at least a
21	preliminary portion where we've got the
22	name and the address and who they are.
23	Then we can follow up on it.
