14	sit someone there.

16	Yeah. And, and let me tell you and
17	where we got into this a lot is with
18	those incinerators, medical (inaudible).
19	And we had several companies to do this.
20	And they got down where they were trying
21	to replace a conditional with a
22	conditional, you know, and it has come
23	down to a point somewhere. But in this
24	situation, your hands are kind of tied.
25	MR. DEABREU:

Let's, let's see --Yes. 2

Ts this --

MR. DEABREU:

-- what the regulations say about So, the conditional certification requirements as follows: first, the, the applicant must request a conditional certificate; second, the board must determine that the applicant is qualified to perform duties at a particular facility. Okay. It's always up to us. And third, the applicant must pass the operator examination and attend one board-approved training class leading up to hours within six, six months. And there's a point to replace or succeed, succeed a regular certificate operator may be issued a conditional certificate application to the board, the payment of the same fees as specified for regular certificates. Application for certification must be made within one year of replacement, or succession must specify the need for

1	conditional certification. So, has to 21
2	be a need, too. After receipt of such
3	conditional certificate, the applicant
4	must take and pass the operator exam,
5	examination in six months, attend ten
6	hours of a board-approved training. If
7	the examinations is passed, the
8	applicant may be shown an additional
9	conditional certificate prior to meeting
10	other requirements for regular
11	certificate. So
12	MR. WYCHE:
13	Well, this kind of goes back to
14	Danny.
15	MR. WYNN:
16	If it is they have to have some kind
17	of experience in that field to be able
18	to hold that position, she has none.
19	MR. DEABREU:
20	Right. Well, at least she didn't on
21	this current application, so
22	MR. WYNN:
23	That's right.
24	MR. DEABREU:
25	Any other discussion before we, we

1	You make a motion to, to approve? 23
2	MR. WYNN:
3	Yes.
4	MR. DEABREU:
5	A motion to approve the application
6	by Mr. Wynn. Do we have hear a
7	second?

5	extended all theirs till December of
6	this year, so his is still in effect.
7	And that was that last packet of stuff.

10	with, but the secondary information we
11	requested was in that last packet that
12	was sent out from him. There's a little
13	letter in there saying it's from till
14	his his Level A in Arkansas is still
15	good until December of this year.
16	MR. WYNN:
17	Do you know if he had any kind of
18	SWANA certifications?
19	MR. GREEN:
20	One or two of them is listed on that
21	DEQ form.
22	MR. WYNN:
23	Was the (inaudible) involved?
24	MR. GREEN:
25	His was, like 50 pages, Bubba, and

1	it's the only one I don't have with me. 26
2	I printed all that off, and I know he's
3	got SWANA. I don't know about MOLO, but
4	I do know he, he had several SWANA's on
5	there. And I could go back and check
6	the emails. But, but he worked up in
7	the Southern Arkansas landfill that
8	the one over in (inaudible).
9	MR. WYNN:
10	Right.
11	MR. WYCHE:
12	The only thing the reciprocity
13	is, is covered if he, if he had a valid
14	Arkansas certificate. And then it might
15	just be a question of making sure he has
16	the hours and, and that those would be
17	
18	MR. GREEN:
19	Well, he had in Arkansas, there was
20	six hours of classes. The last round of
21	information I sent out, he had more than
22	that. I mean, he had every six hour
23	class that he could take, plus some
24	SWANA.
25	MR. HYLTON:

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1	John Helms left also, so in the last two
2	years we've lost two Class A's. So,
3	he's, he's a replacement for Lou, who
4	transferred over to Woolworth Landfill
5	strictly, only.
6	MR. HYLTON:
7	The application has him succeeding
8	John Helms.
9	MR. GREEN:
10	Well, John okay. Lou
11	MR. HYLTON:
12	I understand what you're saying.
13	MR. GREEN:
14	Yeah, John was the main guy in
15	charge until he retired. Lou filled in
16	to help out Webster Parish from
17	Woolworth. And then when they hired
18	Michael, I guess yes, he did replace
19	John, I guess is the way it really is.
20	MR. HYLTON:
21	Yeah, because that's why he put on
22	his app, so
23	MR. GREEN:
24	Yeah, so
25	MR. HYLTON:

1	again, if all the 40 hours are showing 36
2	that he automatically gets his
3	recertification?
4	MR. HYLTON:
5	Well, something along that line, or
6	Kaitlynn can vouch for him, or you
7	know, I'm just looking at his file, and
8	if we approve his file as-is, it's
9	incorrect.
10	MR. WYNN:
11	Right. Right.
12	MR. HYLTON:
13	We need to at least have a footnote
14	there somewhere.
15	MR. DEABREU:
16	Okay. I think that this will be in
17	the same, almost the same place of the
18	incomplete recertification applications
19	that's we're going be doing in a minute.
20	So, I'm going to remove Terrence Stewart
21	and put him in another category.
22	So, any other questions about the
23	other applicants, the remaining
24	applicants where recertification that
25	has complete applications?

1	MR. DRISKILL:
2	On, on Brown, Mr. Brown, one of his
3	certificate of attendance is before he
4	got his license in September of '18. He
5	didn't get his license I mean, yeah,
6	March '18 and didn't get his license
7	till September. So, that's kind of
8	MR. HYLTON:
9	I think there's a couple
10	applications that are the same thing.
11	MR. WYNN:
12	So, they took the course in March
13	and did not get their certification
14	until September; am I correct?
15	MR. DRISKILL:
16	License was issued in September of
17	'18, and one of his certificate of
18	attendance is from March of '18.
19	MR. HYLTON:
20	That's on Terrence Stewart?
21	MR. DRISKILL:
22	No, that's on Macon Brown.
23	MR. HYLTON:
24	I'm sorry. I'm sorry.
25	MR. WYNN:

1	Okay. Well, that's a new one on me.
2	So, in other words, if, if we cannot
3	count that first one in March, then
4	well, this is for a recertification
5	application, so four years is up. What
6	are they gonna have to do, resubmit or
7	what?
8	MR. DRISKILL:
9	Didn't we give them an extra year
10	due to COVID? So, he was inside the
11	attend a workshop
12	MR. HYLTON:
13	Think so.
14	MR. DRISKILL:
15	before September 2023.
16	MS. COURT REPORTER:
17	Mr. Hylton froze.
18	MR. WYNN:
19	Pardon? I didn't understand.
20	MS. COURT REPORTER:
21	Mr. Hylton froze, and now he's off.
22	MR. DEABREU:
23	Oh.
24	MS. COURT REPORTER:
25	There he is.

1	MR. WYNN:
2	So, what is the suggestion going
3	forward with this?
4	MR. DRISKILL:
5	I don't think we can approve this
6	application for recertification for
7	Macon Brown until he attends another
8	workshop.
9	MR. WYNN:
10	Well, that means he would have to
11	complete two workshops this year, this
12	coming year, or make sure to be in the
13	one in Lake Charles in October; am I
14	correct?
15	MR. DRISKILL:
16	Yes, sir.
17	MR. WYNN:
18	Okay.
19	MR. DEABREU:
20	These will, these will be the same.
21	It'll be in the incomplete certification
22	applications that we can't approve based
23	on obtaining the last hours of CEU's.
24	Okay. So, any other application on this
25	list that I just, that I, I first

presented?

MR. WYCHE:

This is Wes. I'm just kind of trying to think through this. I don't remember the board really ever getting into the, the question of how many hours when it's a re, recertification application. I guess I was thinking maybe that was something the board relied upon DEQ to, to confirm that they've taken the hours. And the board might, might pass a motion to say we approve the recertification subject to confirmation that the required hours were obtained.

I know questions come to the board when it's, you know, out-of-state training or something like that. But when it's the SWANA in-state, Louisiana training, I could be, I could be completely wrong. But I guess I was thinking that maybe that wasn't something that, that the board has gotten too involved in. We just kind of -- it's been more of a clerical

2	sort of real seriously.
3	MS. BORDELON:
4	This is Suzanne Bordelon.
5	MR. WYNN:
6	Hey, Suzanne.
7	MS. BORDELON:
8	Hey, everyone. What I just
9	wanted to chime in. Wes is actually
10	correct. With the recertifications, I
11	actually never did send out copies to
12	the board of all the recertifications.
13	I just typically just sent you a list of
14	all the people that were applying for
15	recertification, because I typically
16	just looked at the application and made
17	sure that all their hours were obtained,
18	and then I would just send the list and
19	said, okay, all of these people met
20	their hours and these are the ones that
21	were short the ten hours. So no, you
22	actually never did look at each
23	certificate and see all the dates like
24	you're looking at now.
25	MR. WYNN:

Now, with that being said, when --

because of COVID and us extending the certifications for one additional year, they can, can use that extension to get his last ten hours that he needs.

MR. HYLTON:

Well, that -- you know, that's probably okay, but if, if, if you are going to tell us these are okay, I'd rather not see them. I'd rather go by your word than have all these things in here and then we find something that doesn't look right to us. So, if you have the authority to say these are ready to be certified and all we've got to do is say okay, I'd just soon not see this.

MR. WYNN:

Well, then here it comes down to, to the one we're talking about right now also. Well, then, they still are lacking ten hours certification because the ones they got in March was before the date he got certified, which was in September. So, if you're saying from September to the expiring date, well,

3	MS. BORDELON:
4	I think the board could probably
5	just go ahead and make a motion to go
6	ahead, to go ahead and issue that one
7	once he proves that, that he can that
8	he has that, that certificate.
9	MS. LEGGETT:
10	This is Kaitlynn Leggett. We have
11	that certificate. It was emailed later.
12	But we can send that email again after
13	this meeting that shows that he has that
14	certification, certification.
15	MR. DEABREU:
16	Well, to me if you're saying that he
17	has, that's good enough for me.
18	MR. HYLTON:
19	And we just need to make that part
20	of the motion to accept the application.
21	MR. DEABREU:
22	Right. So, any, any other comments
23	on any other applicants? So, okay. I'm
24	gonna read okay. It's right there in

the video.

2	Pretty clear.

5	the 40 hours. All right.

4	the board, assuming it all adds	
5	up to 40.	
6	MR. GREEN:	
7	I think one year of class he had ten	
8	hours, and then there's several of them
