8		We had talked at one time about
9		persons who miss some of our meetings
10		and whether or not they should remain
11		on the Board.
12	•	Did we ever come to a conclusion on
13		that discussion?
14	Ms.	BORDELON:
15		No.
16	MR.	LAGRANGE:
17		No, we didn't because there's
18		nothing in the regs to my knowledge
19		that addresses that issue. In order to
20		really address it, I think you would
21		need to amend something into the rules
22 .		and regulations relative to that.
23		For instance, with the parish
24	·	government, we appoint members to all
25		types of boards and commissions. And

1		we have an ordinance in place that
2		requires that when a board member
3		misses three consecutive monthly
4		meetings, that the parish council be
5	•	notified. And then we contact that
6		member and say, hey, you missed three
7	•	consecutive meetings. Is there a.
8		problem? Are you still continuing to
9		want to serve? Typically, once you
10		make that contact, they either realize
11		hey, I don't have time to serve so I'm
12		going to resign, or they start
13		attending the meetings.
14		Very, very seldom do we have to,
15	ı	the council have to take action to
16		actually involuntarily replace someone
17		for failure to attend meetings.
18		So something similar would probably
19		have to be amended into the regs to
20		address that absenteeism of board
21		members at our meetings.
22	MR.	BERTHOLOT:
23		And how would we go about that?
24	MR.	LAGRANGE:
25		That would probably need to make a

1	Tormar request to DEO to consider doing
2	that. Would that be an appropriate
3	process?
.4	MR. MOLLERE:
5	Of course it would take public
6	hearings and publication in the
7	register and all that process.
· 8	MR. LAGRANGE:
9 .	So it may be better just to
10	hopefully seek out and solicit future
11	nominees for the Board that really, you
12	know, willing and able to make the
13	commitment.
14	MR. WILLIAMS:
15	Well, I guess in certain instances,
16	we can contact the nominating body to
17	make them aware about the person they
18	nominated.
19	MR. LAGRANGE:
20	That's correct. That's also
21	another option to make them aware that
22	the nominating body is aware that the
23	folks who were nominated and appointed
24	to the Board to represent their them is
25	not attending meetings; therefore,

1 they're not getting the proper 2 representation they should be getting 3 by the Board. That's also another avenue that we 5 can take, wither it's Louisiana Municipal Association, Police Jury Association, private industry, 8 professional organizations, whatever. 9 MR. MOLLERE: 10 At one point, I think we had talked 11 about. Because private industry taking 12 over more of the landfills, it's actually one representative from LMA 13 14 and one from police jury and making 15 those private industries to two from 16 LMA, two from police jury, and have 17 four from private industry. 18 And I think when we got to 19 discussing that, we decided that would 20 probably not be the best thing to do 21 because we needed that input from our 22 governmental agencies. 23 MR. LAGRANGE: 24 Suzanne, you'll report back on once 25 you send those nominating letters and

1	what we have.
