1	Slidell Fire Department
2	MR. RUIZ:
3	Old business?
4	Slidell Louisiana has been calling me, Chief Chris
5	Kaufmann, about some problems he has been having about back
6	pay, Susan. Have you discussed anything with him at all
7	about his?
8	MS. ROBERTS:
9	I don't have any right now for back pay really for
10	MR. RUIZ:
11	All right. This is Anthony something or other. Would
12	you hand that to her? We'll do them one at a time.
13	All I can do is I have reviewed it. I
14	MS. ROBERTS:
15	His effective date is this someone that is getting
16	supplemental pay?
17	MR. RUIZ:
18	Uh-huh.
19	MS. ROBERTS:
20	He's already on?
21	MR. RUIZ:
22	Uh-huh.
23	MS. ROBERTS:
24	Why does it say Picayune Fire Department?
25	MR. RUIZ:

Because that is where he was prior to that, that's what 1 -- I went over it with him, too, and found he had -- but 2 3 you've got to look at the dates that --MS. ROBERTS: 4 5 He got hired 1/20/11. MR. RUIZ: 6 7 Right. MS. ROBERTS: 9 Why does he get Act 110 money? Because, first of all, I 10 made a mistake on this. He shouldn't be getting supplemental 11 pay yet. MR. RUIZ: 12 13 Okay. That's why I'm here. We are going to try to check 14 it. 15 MS. ROBERTS: He's not eligible until 1/20/12. 16 MR. RUIZ: 17 18 Okay. He said he has prior service. MS. ROBERTS: 19 20 It don't matter. MR. RUIZ: 21 22 He had to have prior service in Louisiana, that is what 23 I explained to him the other day. So you're telling me he doesn't have prior service? 24 25 MS. ROBERTS:

He -- if he --1 MR. RUIZ: 2 3 I'm calling the gentleman on my way home. I kind of thought the same thing you said. 4 MS. ROBERTS: 5 Yes. I would have never -- I have someone who helps me. 6 I'm not blaming it on her, but -- because I go over them 7 after her, but if we put him on, we'll be taking him off 8 until -- what I do on these that I make mistakes on, I take 9 them off until they catch up with their repay or they can 10 just go ahead and send it back to me. 11 12 He's not eligible until 1/20/12. MR. RUIZ: 13 Okay. Let me write that down then, so --14 MS. ROBERTS: 15 I mean, I could have made a mistake. I would have 16 17 never counted --MR. RUIZ: 18 Just so I understand, I spoke with this gentleman 19 vesterday, and he said he had prior service in Louisiana. 20 MS. ROBERTS: 21 Maybe he does, but I don't see that. I wouldn't have 22 put him on without -- I mean, I could have been in a rush 23 doing it. He shouldn't be getting supplemental pay. I mean, 24 25 as soon as I picked it up, I saw that.

2		All right. You're saying he should get it what day?
3	MS.	ROBERTS:
4		1/20/12.
5	MR.	RUIZ:
6		1/20/12, and they're saying
7	MS.	ROBERTS:
8		Unless he has prior service somewhere else.

10		That's what I'm trying
11	MS.	ROBERTS:
12		Let me go pull his app, that would be the easiest thing

14	MR.	RUIZ:
15		It says here Fire District No. 1.
16		What I want you to do, I will talk to Chief Kaufmann
17	aga:	in on my way home. They are going to have to prove to us
18	tha	t he had prior service. These papers that he sent
19	MS.	ROBERTS:
20		When did he send it to me; what is the date?
21	MR.	RUIZ:
22		February let's see. This was sent 4 mailed
23	4/2	9/11.
24	MS.	ROBERTS:
25		Yes. He shouldn't be getting supplemental pay.

25	This one here, the gentleman says, in regards to	

Anthony, he received \$183 in January 2012. Due to his hire date of 1/20/11, he had prior service -- from his hire date, as a result, he would be entitled to \$5,817 in back pay from 2011.

What she was saying is that the prior service -- based on what she sees, is from a different state. It isn't from the state of Louisiana. What I'm going to have to get him to do is show us -- we don't have any problems paying him, but he's got to send some documents to Susan showing that he had prior service in the state of Louisiana.

MS. ROBERTS:

And he was getting -- but the people that I count their prior service are people that maybe were at a department where they were working full-time, paid full-time.

MR. RUIZ:

Yes. I would like to entertain a motion to have Susan research it, and if we can get the proof that these gentlemen had prior service in the state of Louisiana, that we don't have to wait until the next meeting to approve it, that she can have the authority to go ahead and pay these people, if they are due their money. If they are not, then they don't get no money.

MR. COTTEN:

He's got his Firefighter I certification?

MR. RUIZ:

He's got that. He's got all that. He's got a 1 Yes. 2 transfer from Mississippi to Louisiana. He's got all that 3 already. Both of these gentlemen do. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 4 What is the date in Louisiana? 5 MR. RUIZ: 6 2000 -- 8th day of December, 2000. He transferred from Mississippi. You all know more about that than me. I even 8 9 asked him if he did this. MR. COTTEN: 10 There's a reciprocity number, but, again, it says you 11 12 have to have it from here, so it's either this date or his 13 year of service, that is why I was asking. 14 MR. RUIZ: That is why I was asking. You all know more about that 15 16 than me. I asked him to send me that for both of these gentlemen, that way, we'll have all this when we're 17 discussing this. I mean, I don't know if it's legal to do 18 19 what I want to do. We can ask Paul. I just don't want -- if we can work this out and figure out whether we owe him within 20 21 the next month --22 MS. ROBERTS: We've had this before, though, where we don't pay them 23 out of state. I mean --24 25 MR. RUIZ:

Well, I don't want it coming from out of state. 1 are going to have to prove to us that they had prior service 2 3 in state. MS. ROBERTS: 4 5 In state, okay. MR. COTTEN: 6 7 So your motion is, he's got to prove that he was in Louisiana, worked full-time in Louisiana, and had drawn supplemental pay in Louisiana before? 10 MR. RUIZ: No, he didn't have to draw. 11 MS. ROBERTS: 12 13 But he had to be --14 MR. RUIZ: 15 Eligible. MS. ROBERTS: 16 I do have people that, say, come from Alexandria with 17 18 nine months and then they go to Slidell and they make their three months up. We do count that time, but they may not 19 have -- he may not have gotten supplemental pay at Alexandria, 20 so once he became eligible, even if he left --21 22 MR. RUIZ: I understand totally what you're doing. 23 24 MR. COTTEN: I understand what you're asking for, but I have a 25

problem because his application should have reflected the 1 prior service in Louisiana. 2 3 MR. RUIZ: 4 Yes. MR. COTTEN: 5 If the application is wrong, then he needs to reapply. 6 7 MS. ROBERTS: 8 I can't wait to pull that application. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 10 Yes, that's what I'm thinking, maybe we should just wait and see what they submit, because, obviously, they didn't 11 submit it the first time around. 12 13 MS. ROBERTS: Is that what he submitted, though? 14 MR. RUIZ: 15 I've got everything. 16 Yes. 17 MS. ROBERTS: Let me go pull it. Do you all want me, too? 18 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 19 What he submitted is from another state. What is he 20 going to do now, come back and say, oh, by the way, I 21 22 forgot --MR. RUIZ: 23 He's going to have to come -- I understand what you all 24 25 are saying.

MR. ROBICHAUX: 1 The prior service says Picayune. 2 MR. RUIZ: 3 The prior service says Diamondhead on this one. 4 Review that for me Chief Roy and see if you see anything 5 different on there than what I saw. 6 MR. ROBICHAUX: 7 The prior service says Picayune. 8 9 MR. RUIZ: Is there anything besides that on there? 10 MR. ROBICHAUX: 11 12 No. This is where it asks if you had prior service, and it says from 2000 --13 MR. RUIZ: 14 This one says Bay St. Louis. 15 MR. PRICE: 16 I'm totally confused about where he had prior service 17 1.8 at. MR. RUIZ: 19 Well, he was supposed to come here today, according to 20 what Ronnie told me, but he's not here. I wish he would have 21 22 came. MR. SCHILLACE: 23 He called and spoke to me about it briefly. He didn't 24 25 go into real detail and said he would try to make it.

MR. RUIZ: 1 2 Well, he's out of luck. All right. I'll withdraw my motion. We'll straighten 3 4 this out one way or another. MS. ROBERTS: 5 He's probably going to -- instead of getting back pay, 6 he's going to have to pay us is what is going to happen. It 7 would have came up anyway because we do little checks every so often, and it would have come up. 10 MR. RUIZ: 11 Everything we see is from Mississippi. MS. ROBERTS: 12 Yes. He is not -- he should not be getting supplemental 13 14 pay. 15 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: His address is Picayune. It's showing he's working for 16 17 Picayune up until the present, now. MS. ROBERTS: 18 Yes. I saw that. 19 MR. ROBICHAUX: 20 He might be at both fire departments. I have one doing 21 the same thing. He's working in Waveland and --22 23 MS. ROBERTS: Do you know they're getting supplemental pay? 24 MR. RUIZ: 25

1 Yes. 2 MS. ROBERTS: Did you see him on our list? 3 MR. RUIZ: 4 This gentleman said he received \$183 in January 5 6 2012, that is -- it's on the top page. MS. ROBERTS: As soon as I get back to my desk, I'm pulling it. 8 (Off-the-record discussion.) 9 MR. RUIZ: 10 11 I'm finished with my old business. Ronnie, do you got anything else? 12 MR. SCHILLACE: 13 14 Well, I noticed on here before we approve this list, I 15 do know for a fact we had a captain that retired from Hammond one day, and the next day, he went to work for Natalbany Fire 16 Department, and he did fill out the paperwork, his chief did, 17 and supposedly sent it in, John Polito, Jr. 18 MS. ROBERTS: 19 There are no apps left. I did everything through 20 21 yesterday. MR. SCHILLACE: 22 Okay. So I am just going by what he told me. 23 MS. ROBERTS: 24 25 Yes.

MR. SCHILLACE: He apparently didn't do it because it's not on this 2 list, okay. So I'll just report back to him, because he had 3 said it was in, and I would state that, hey, it wasn't. MR. ROBICHAUX: 5 Susan, I'm asking about a Raphael from our parish, I 6 don't see on the list. Actually, I forgot him the last time 7 with that big group that was approved. MS. I'll have a debate with him on the way home. 4 MS. ROBERTS: 5 They do that, though. They will just tell you bits and 6 7 pieces when --MR. RUIZ: I'll have a debate with him on the way home. If he can 9 prove what he says is true, he'll have to come here and bring 10 11 his boys to the next meeting and prove it. MS. ROBERTS: 12 Yes. We did not give him his first check until January, 13 though. He has not been getting supplemental pay. It makes 14 me feel better. 15 MR. RUIZ: 16 17 I will talk to the Chief. I'll call him on my way home, and I am going to say, look, we reviewed it, and we don't see 18 what you're telling us is fact, so you're going to have to 19 20 come here at the next meeting and prove it. If you can prove 21 it, I'll give the gentleman whatever back pay we sit fit, you 2.2 know. I'll tell him on my way home. 23 MS. ROBERTS: I'll call him. 24

MR. RUIZ:

Any more new business? 1 MR. ROBICHAUX: 2 I have a question. When I walked in, you all were 3 talking about military leave. 4 MR. RUIZ: 5 Oh, that was off the record, but we can discuss it now. 6 MR. ROBICHAUX: 7 That's why I'm asking now. 8 9 I have one that left for basic training. He wasn't 10 activated. He joined the Reserves. MS. ROBERTS: 11 Is that the one you were telling me about? 12 MR. ROBICHAUX: 13 14 He went to basic training. We're not paying him while 15 he is at basic training, so I asked Susan to take him off supplemental pay. He's not receiving any pay from the fire 16 department, until he has finished his basic training and 17 18 comes back to work in 14 weeks. 19 MR. RUIZ: The way the law is today, you're right. 20 What we did was, I introduced legislation through my organization, if 21 22 you've got six months on the job and you are already in the 23 service, because he asked this question about somebody 24 joining --MR. ROBICHAUX: 25

1	This guy just joined.
2	MR. RUIZ:
3	Right.
4	MR. ROBICHAUX:
5	He's just going on basic training, not
6	MS. ROBERTS:
7	Unless I'm wrong, to receive supplemental pay, you have
8	to be called to active duty.
9	MR. ROBICHAUX:
10	Correct.
11	MS. ROBERTS:
12	And so, if they're just going for training, we do not pay
13	ever.
14	MR. RUIZ:
15	There you go.
16	MS. ROBERTS:
17	We pay declaration of war or a national emergency. I
18	mean, when you read it, it's really, really clear. So, if
19	it's training, the only people we pay training for is if they
20	are being deployed and they have active orders and those
21	orders say they have been called to active duty to Iraqi
22	Freedom, or whatever, it is.
23	MR. ROBICHAUX:
24	That's right. I do have that. It is exactly what it
25	says.

MS. ROBERTS:

I have read it so many times to people.

MR. RUIZ:

Like the gentlemen we hire, we're different because we pay 100 percent of our guys, and when you walked in -- we have a guy that just got hired and he had to go to training. He's an MP and he has to go to Afghanistan for eight or nine months, whatever.

MS. ROBERTS:

Those trainings we pay for if they're being deployed.

MR. RUIZ:

Right, but he's not eligible for supplemental pay yet.

Remember when we were debating with the Police, you had six months on, you've got your Firefighter I, Police I, whatever, and then they were deployed, then they had to come back -- a year later, they come back, and they've still got to serve six months, well, the legislation that we're presenting is going allow them to serve their six months active while they're serving our country. Instead of coming back and serving six more months, they're at war, they're fighting for us, we're going to count that six months while they're over there. Still, the legislation has got to pass. I mean, I don't think we're going to have a problem with it.

MR. SCHEXNAYDER:

The firemen tried that last year, and it didn't go

1	through.
2	MS. ROBERTS:
3	Yes, I know.
4	MR. RUIZ:
5	Yes, I know, but we we've
6	MR. COTTEN:
7	I've got the same situation. I have a guy that is 31
8	and think he wants to join now.
9	MR. RUIZ:
10	We've got it introduced. We've got some good people
11	that is going to back it, and we've got some military people
12	that is going to be involved.
13	MR. COTTEN:
14	You'll give it another shot.
15	MR. RUIZ:
16	We'll give it another shot.
17	MS. ROBERTS:
18	If they're going for training, though, and they are out
19	for three months and they haven't met their year, those three
20	months won't count?
21	MR. RUIZ:
22	No, no. It's people who is going
23	MS. ROBERTS:
