I can give you, you know -- I can tell you what 5 the law is. 6 MR. RUIZ: 7 I didn't read it. 8 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 9 I mean, it shows, you know, his pay stub shows he's paid 10 by City of New Orleans. The organizational chart shows that 11 he works under a fire department operations chief. He's got 12 -- obviously, there is a fire department there that he 13 14 supervises. MR. RUIZ: 15 In other words, the fire department he is chief of is 16 not recognized under the statute, is what you're telling me? 17 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 18 Well, you know, the statute says political subdivisions, 19 and, you know, I think you were here when we had the Port 20 Authority come in. In fact, we just make them go to the 21 legislature because they didn't have the certification from 22 LSU. It seems like they had a maritime firefighting. 23 MR. RUIZ: 24

That was one of the reasons, and then they went to

25		It's yes. It's through the City of New Orleans, but

I don't work for the New Orleans Fire Department. I work for 1 2 the City. MR. RUIZ: 3 It's strange because what happens is, he works for the 4 City. The fireman he oversees actually work for the City and 5 get paid by the City. 6 MR. ROBICHAUX: 7 8 Who is going to sign the warrant? 9 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: That is the question, who's going to sign that warrant. 10 MR. TIBBETTS: 11 I've spoken to the -- I spoke to my immediate 12 supervisor, Walter Krygowski. He directors (sic) the report 13 for the mayor, so I guess the director could sign it. He 14 would sign it, or I don't know if I need to Colonel Sneed. 15 MR. RUIZ: 16 Who is signing for the City of New Orleans? 17 MR. TIBBETTS: 18 Colonel Sneed. 19 MR. RUIZ: 20 Colonel Sneed does? 21 MR. TIBBETTS: 22 From what I gather, yes. 23 MR. Instead of having directors that he 16 used to go it, he's got a mayor of Homeland -- deputy mayor 17 of Homeland Security. The CEO is something they have like this, and where Mitch got these ideas from, I really don't 18 know, but that is just the way he does it, and that's why --19 20 MR.
