CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Todd Parker at 9:31 a.m.

Removed from the agenda, the case changed from a charge letter to a warning letter.

Allen Celestine, Case No. 2443

The Department charged Mr. Celestine with:

One (1) violation of LRS 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(H)(1)

One (1) violation of LRS 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.119(D)

One (1) violation of LRS 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.119(E)

One (1) violation of LRS 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.141(D)(1)(a-d)

Ms. Burkett admitted LDAF's Exhibits 1(charge letter) and 2 (executed stipulation) into the record.

Mr. Celestine was not present. Respondent admits to allegations and agrees to pay the penalty of \$1,700.00 with \$500.00 being suspended within 30-days after receipt of the Commission's acceptance. The stipulation was signed by all parties.

Motion: Mr. Edward Reynolds made a motion to accept the facts set forth in the stipulation and that the penalty be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Todd Parker and passed unanimously.

Mr. Mathieu was not present. Respondent admits to allegations and agrees to pay the penalty of \$2,000.00 within 30-days after receipt of the Commission's acceptance. The stipulation was signed by all parties.

Motion: Mr. Jarrod Horton made a motion to accept the facts set forth in the stipulation and that the penalty be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Edward Reynolds and passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Research Committee - Todd Parker

Mr. Todd Parker updated the commission on the following:

• Findings made during the Research Committee Meeting held June 9, 2022.

Ms. Kiara Moore presented the following:

- Research summary of LSU Structural Pest Control Dr. Quian 'Karen' Sun
 - 1. Soil moisture: what doesn't kill them makes them stronger
 - The Formosan subterranean termites are not able to survive when soil moisture is 1% or lower
 - They can adapt to 5% soil moisture by producing a greater amount of wax as a protective body coating, which allows them to better tolerate a drier environment
 - 2. Vitamin K3 can be potentially used for termite control
 - Vitamin K3 effectively kills and repels Formosan subterranean termites at a low concentration (6 ppm through soil treatment)
 - 3. Updates on pest control training programs
 - LSU/LPMA Winter Institute (January 2022, 16 participants)
 - Lois Caffey Termite Training Program (2 master and 2 basic classes, 72 participants since September 2021)

Motion: Mr. Jarrod Horton made a motion to accept the Research Committee's recommendation to continue research funding to LSU of \$50,000. The motion was seconded by Mr. Edward Reynolds and passed unanimously. Dr. James Ottea recused himself.
