#### VIII. Discuss/Approve Lease for laydown yard

Darla Perry stated that they have an offer for the 11.2 acre Sempra laydown yard for piping of \$2,500 per month per acre for inactive use, and \$3,500 for active use.

After a brief discussion, Mike Granger offered a motion giving Dalton Langford authority to execute the lease with Sempra Global for 11.2 acres for a laydown yard, 2nd by Chad Guidry. No opposition. Motion carried.

### IX. Discuss/Approve quotes for the road repair

Dala Perry said the parish stated that if the airport purchased the culverts that the parish would supply the other materials at cost. The total cost falls below the public bid amount, so they can go with the lowest of three quotes.

After a brief discussion, Mike Granger offered a motion giving Tim LaFleur the authority to proceed with the road repair bidding and securing a contract and Meyer & Associates to review, 2nd by Tommy Little. No opposition. Motion carried.

## X. Finance Report

Darla Perry reported that for July – December the airport is close on revenue for budget to actual, and under on expenditures largely because they haven't started purchasing the insurance and grant management has been less. She also reported that they have collected over \$4.7 million from FEMA so far.

Chad Guidry offered a motion to accept the Finance Report as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Granger. No opposition. Motion carried.

## XI. <u>Director's Report</u>

Tim LaFleur reported that the hangar work is continuing slowly. Angelico had been working on the T Hangars, but he hasn't seen them at all this week. He's not sure what they are waiting on.

The terminal foundation is completely formed. They are waiting on the door and window frames to be delivered.

He stated that he contacted several airports to compare what they charge for hangar space. Once they get insurance quotes they will have to determine what the rental fees will be.

After a brief discussion, Mike Granger made a motion to accept the Director's Report as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tommy Little. No opposition. Motion carried.

#### XII. Engineer's Report

Chuck Stutes reported that hangar B should be wrapped up by next month. With the foundation poured for the terminal building, that should be moving forward quickly. With the door panels messed up on Hangar A, that project has slowed. The apron expansion project should be underway in late February.

After a brief discussion, Chad Guidry made a motion to accept the Engineer's Report as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Granger. No opposition. Motion carried.
