**I. Call to Order**

**III. Approval of Minutes**

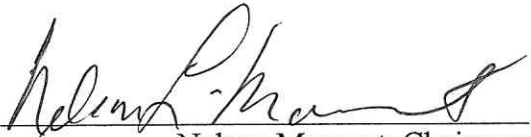
Mr. Huggins made a motion to approve the September 25, 2019 minutes. Mr. Daniel seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**IV. Discussion of Job Description/Qualifications/Salary for Executive Director**

Mr. Morvant discussed the job description and qualifications of a full time executive director. Mr. Daniel suggested asking The Water Institute of the Gulf to research what are the qualifications and job descriptions of Executive Directors in other ground water districts. Mr. Huggins suggested that the Groundwater Management Districts Association would be a good resource. Mr. Daniel suggested contacting some professional recruiters and getting quotes. Mr. Daniel suggested that one candidate for Executive Director be recommended to the full board. Mr. Daniel suggested that the Executive Committee work up a broad job description and then the professional recruiter can help develop a job description. The committee decided to present a preliminary timeline and a general job description with a quote from the professional recruiters at the next full board meeting.
