NOTICE AND CERTIFICATION OF CAUSE TO HOLD VIRTUAL MEETING

In accordance with Section 2 of the Governor's Proclamation Number 59 JBE 2020: Renewal of State of Emergency for COVID-19 Extension of Emergency Provisions, The Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority — East will hold its May board meeting, scheduled for Thursday, May 21, 2020, virtually via video conference.
