The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence from James C. Bruno, attorney for Fisker Automotive, Inc., dated January 28, 2011, requesting waiver of the million-dollar bond pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a).

"We represent Fisker Automotive, Inc., of Irvine, California ("Fisker"). It will be filing an application for a motor vehicle manufacturer license in the near future. I request a waiver of the \$1,000,000 bond requirement; and that this matter be considered at the March 14, 2011 meeting of the Commission.

Fisker is well capitalized. An article on Fisker is attached. Fisker is in the fore of green technology. The requirement of bond in the amount of \$1,000,000 is not required to protect the parties. Most states do not require bonds for manufacturers. A couple of them do, Indiana and north Carolina require respectively \$25,000.00 and \$50,000.00. In addition, Fisker will have limited distribution in the state of Louisiana and likely only one dealer when distribution begins. There is limited opportunity for harm.

We believe that the facts described above give strong reasons to accept our request to waive the \$1,000,000 bond requirements. If required, please consider it at the March 14, 2011 meeting of the Commission.

Please advise if presence of counsel or representative at the meeting is advisable. We have no representative in Louisiana. If you have any question do not hesitate to contact me."

The Executive Director advised the Commission Members Fisker, to date, has not submitted license application nor a financial statement. Due to the lack of information, the Chairman defer Fisker's request to the next meeting.

The Executive Director reported to the Commission that during the 2009 Legislative changes wherein the licensing and regulation of recreational products was moved from the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle Commission to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, the requirement for a recreational products dealer to obtain a separate license when selling "used" product had been left out of the statute in the form of the following exemption:

"LSA-R.S. 32:1254E (9) (d) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, any motor vehicle or recreational products dealer holding a license hereunder shall not be required to obtain a license as a motor vehicle lessor, used motor vehicle dealer, or specialty vehicle dealer or converter, when modifying or selling those vehicles or products he is duly franchised and licensed to sell, provided such operations are conducted from the location from which said motor vehicle or recreational products dealer is licensed to do business. (Acts 2009, No. 403, §1, eff. July 7, 2009)"

However, in the 2010 Legislative changes, LSA-R.S. 32:1254E(9)(d) was amended as follows, thus creating the need for recreational products dealers to apply for a separate license to sell used product:

"LSA-R.S. 32:1254E (9) (d) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, any motor vehicle dealer holding a license hereunder shall not be required to obtain a license as a motor vehicle lessor, used motor vehicle dealer, or specialty vehicle dealer or converter, when modifying or selling those vehicles he is duly franchised and licensed to sell, provided such operations are conducted from the location from which such motor vehicle dealer is licensed to do business. (2010 Legislative Changes)"

The Commission Members representing the recreational products industry reported to the Commission Members the feedback from the 2010 Legislative change. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Westbrook made a motion to have LSA-R.S. 32:1254E(9) amended in the 2011 Legislative Session to include the same exemption from Act No. 403 of the 2009 Legislative Session. Commissioner Bent seconded this motion.

At this time, Commissioner LeBlanc reported to the Commission Members regarding the research that had been done on raising the surety bond amount and/or providing other means of protecting the consumers of Louisiana with regard to lien payoffs and sales taxes, titles, and registration when buying a vehicle. After a lengthy discussion, the Chairman defer this topic for one year for further research and study.

The Executive Director announced that the next topic is the ongoing efforts of Commissioners Westbrook, Bent, Hicks and Tarver and Counselor McCranie regarding the propose changes of the recreational trade show rules and presented the Commission Members with the following draft:

Chapter 15. Recreational Product Shows

§1501. Authorization for Recreational Product Show

A. The commission may authorize or prohibit recreational product shows at offsite locations.

§1503. Application for Show Permit

A. The promoter of a recreational product show shall be required to obtain a license for the show from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:

1. the application shall be on a form prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;
2. a license fee of \$500;
3. the license shall be for the recreational product show subject of the application.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1505. Show Requirements

A. The application must be submitted to the commission no less than 60 days prior to the opening date of the event.

B. Only licensed recreational product dealers whose area of responsibility includes the show site may display and conduct sales of recreational products at such sales and shows.

C. All licensed recreational product dealers within 30 miles of the show's location must be offered the opportunity to participate in the show.

E. Each respective manufacturer shall grant authority to the respective dealers participating to conduct the sale or show of recreational products at the proposed offsite location.

F. Not less than 30 days prior to the opening day of the show the commission must receive a list of all participating licensed recreational product dealers together with the consent of each respective manufacturer.

G. Participation by a licensed recreational product dealer shall include display of vehicles and presence of dealer personnel.

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1507. Definitions

Display Permit—a license issued to a nonresident exhibitor to display recreational products at a show. The permit issued shall be for the duration of the show only and shall not exceed 14 days.

Nonresident Exhibitor—a nonresident recreational product dealer, manufacturer or distributor who holds a current license in another state and whose Louisiana business: (i) is limited to participation in recreational product shows in this state; (ii) whose franchise includes parishes in Louisiana as a part of their area of responsibility for the

vehicle(s) they wish to display at a recreational products show in this state; and (iii) whose established place of business is within 30 miles of the Louisiana state border.

Promoter—any person who alone or with others assumes the financial responsibility of a recreational products show in which recreational products are displayed by licensed dealers, manufacturers or distributors, or non resident exhibitors.

Rally—an event held and organized by recreational product clubs of specific product owners or manufacturers of specific products where owners of the specific products are members of the club and are invited to participate in the event.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1509. License Fees and Applications

A. Promoters shall obtain a license from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:

1. the application for license shall be on forms prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;

2. a license fee of \$500;

3. a promoter's license shall expire on December 31.

B. Nonresident exhibitors shall obtain a display permit from the commission and its request for a display permit shall consist of the following:

1. a copy of its current license and bond, if required, issued by the state in which it conducts its business;

2. the application for a display permit shall be on forms prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to determine the qualification and eligibility of the applicant;

3. an application fee of \$500.

C. All applications to the commission for display permits not received within 30 days of that start of the trade show or exposition shall be charged a \$50 late processing fee.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1511. Invitations and Priority

The promoter shall contact and invite potential participants to a recreational products show as follows:

1. The promoter shall first contact all recreational product dealers who sell the type of vehicle to be displayed at the recreational product show whose location is within a 30 mile radius of the show. Dealers, whose area of responsibility includes the show site, who accept the invitation to attend the show shall exclude all other dealers from displaying or showing the particular make of recreational products sold by them and displayed at the recreational products show.

2. The promoter may invite, but shall accept any request from a recreational product dealer, not excluded by 1, above, whose business is conducted beyond the 30 mile radius whose area of responsibility includes the show site.

3. If a recreational products trade show is being held in a location where a recreational product does not have a dealer whose area of responsibility includes the show's location it shall be the manufacturer's responsibility to determine which licensee will represent that manufacturer at the show. Proximity to the show location shall determine which dealer has the first right of refusal to participate in a show based upon the shortest land based route.

4. The promoter may then invite any nonresident exhibitor to attend the recreational products show to display and show any recreational product not displayed or shown by a recreational product dealer. The nonresident exhibitor shall not be allowed to offer for sale any recreational product.

5. The promoter shall maintain all records of invited, participating and declining dealers and shall furnish these records to the commission 10 days prior to the opening of the recreational products show.

6. A recreational vehicle manufacturer or distributor may exhibit its recreational products at a show only through a recreational products dealer.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1513. Off-Site Displays of Recreational Products

A. The executive director must approve all off-site displays by licensed recreational products dealers. A request for an off-site display must be received and approved by the executive director 10 days prior to the commencement of the display.

B. The location of any off-site display must be within the dealer's area of responsibility.

C. An off-site display of recreational products is limited to a single dealer and shall not exceed 9 days.

D. A recreational products dealer may have only 4 off-site displays per calendar year and at the same location only once each 6 months.

E. The number of vehicles at any off-site display of recreational products will be left to the discretion of the executive director, with a maximum of 20 vehicles.

F. The presence of any sales personnel, business cards, brochures, pricing sheets and other points of sales devices will be allowed to answer consumer questions. However, recreational products cannot be delivered from the off-site display location.

§1515. Licensee Participation in a Rally

A. Closed rally

1. A rally conducted and limited to a single product line.

2. The rally is not open to the general public and there shall be no advertising to the general public.

3. Only licensees of the commission may participate.

4. Only new and unused vehicles may be displayed.

5. Licensees shall apply to the commission for a permit to participate in the rally from the commission at least 20 days prior to the opening of the rally and shall pay a fee of \$100 to the commission. Any application received after that date shall be charged a \$50 late fee.

B. Open rally

1. A rally conducted with multiple product lines invited to participate

2. The rally is not open to the general public and there shall be no advertising to the general public.

3. Only licensees of the commission may participate.

4. Only new and unused vehicles may be displayed.

5. Licensees shall apply to the commission for a permit to participate in the rally from the commission at least 20 days prior to the opening of the rally and shall pay a fee of \$100 to the commission. Any application received after that date shall be charged a \$50 late fee.

6. All licensees of the displayed product line must be invited.

C. A rally is subject to all provisions of this Chapter related to recreational product shows.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on February 9, 2011 from Glen Fritscher, General Manager of Acadiana Dodge, Inc.:

"This is a formal request for an off-site display of vehicles for Acadiana Dodge Chrysler Jeep and Ram.

The request is for the sole sponsorship of the Ram Rodeo Series Southwest Black Rodeo at the Cajun Dome March 26, 2011. I am requesting to display twelve (12) new cars and trucks at the Cajundome for this event.

We have invested thousands of dollars into this event and greatly appreciate your indulgence so as to make this event productive.

This request is for display purposes only, not intended for any type of selling or customer contact.

If you should need further information, please contact me at (337) 232-7361 or reply by fax at (337) 232-7362."

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hargroder made a motion to approve Acadiana Dodge's request to display twelve (12) new cars and trucks at the Ram Rodeo Series Southwest Black Rodeo conditioned upon the Law and the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Commission being strictly adhered to and all representations made in the request correspondence of February 9, 2011, remaining constant. Commissioner Ryan seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on February 28, 2011 from Alaina T. Carlson of Courtesy Automotive Group:

"This Letter is to request written permission to display four GMC's and four Cadillac's at The Louisiana Open as a sponsor. This event will be held on March 21, 2011 until March 27, 2011 located at Le Triomphe Golf Club, 100 Club Drive, Broussard.

We would greatly appreciate your written approval.

Please advise me if you have any questions and forward me a copy of you approval for our files. Our fax number is (337) 769-2265."

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to approve Courtesy Automotive Group's request to display four GMC's and four Cadillac's at The Louisiana Open conditioned upon the Law and the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Commission being strictly adhered to and all representations made in the request correspondence of February 28, 2011, remaining constant. Commissioner Ryan seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

With regard to old business of January 10, 2011 meeting and the December 17, 2010 request by Roy M. D'Aquila, Esq. on behalf of Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc. for a waiver of the million-dollar bond, the Executive Director reported to the Commission that after reviewing Deep South Fire Trucks' financial statement, Chairman Brandt approved the bond waiver request pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a).




