Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners Meeting Minutes September 11, 2020 Via Zoom

Tumlin welcomed everyone to the meeting and reviewed the agenda. He opened the floor for comments from the public, and there were none.

Legal Counsel Report

Spaht provided an update on actions related to proposed rulemaking by LAPELS seeking to define the incidental practice of engineering as it relates to architecture as set forth in a proposed amendment to LAC 46:LXI.105. He reported that LAPELS had indicated interest in continuing the dialogue of the Incidental Practice Task Force to address issues that had been raised in the letter of opposition that we submitted in February 2020. He then led the Board in a strategy session regarding potential paths forward.

LAC 46.I.1109 Licensure for Military Applicants

He then reported that HB613 passed in the 2020 Regular Session which directed Boards to update their rules regarding the licensing of military applicants, their spouses, and dependents. He and Hillegas will be working to adapt changes to LAC 46.I.1109 to comply with HB613. A draft rule change will be presented at a future meeting.

Minutes

The Board reviewed the minutes of the June 5, 2020 meeting.

Motion #1: Bacque/Blitch: To approve the minutes of the June 5, 2020 meeting. Passed. 7-0.

The Board then reviewed the minutes of the June 15, 2020 meeting.

Motion #2: LeBlanc/Singh: To approve the minutes of the June 15, 2020 meeting. Passed. 7-0.

CRC Report

LeBlanc and Ducote reported that the CRC continued discussions regarding ongoing investigations and that there were no items that required Board action. LeBlanc indicated that one of the discussions revealed a weakness in the law as it relates to the design and development of multi-family residences and that there may be an opportunity to strengthen the language in the law.

Licenses Issued for Ratification

Hillegas reported the following registrations had been issued since the last Board meeting:

She noted that the Licensing Report now includes information on reinstated licenses issued.

Motion #3: Brinson/Singh: To approve the list of licenses and certificates of authority issued for the period May 27, 2020, through September 4, 2020. **Passed. 7-0.**

Executive Directors Report

Architect Selection Board

Hillegas presented the Board with candidates for Regions 2 and 5 for the Architect Selection Board. She noted that this information had been previously delivered to Board members in July, and no objections to the candidates were received.

Motion #4: LeBlanc/Brinson: That the Board approve the following individuals for service on the Architect Selection Board for the period September 16, 2020, through September 15, 2021.

June 2020 Financial Statements

Hillegas reported that the fiscal year ended with a total revenue of \$706K compared to budgeted revenue of \$708K. Firm revenue was slightly below budget at 94.37%, and individual revenues came in on budget. She reported that initial licensure revenue was down, primarily due to the closure of Prometric Test Centers from late March to mid-June. Total expenses came in at \$639K vs. the \$805K budgeted and were 25% below projection. Travel and out of state conferences and conventions expenditures were down due to travel restrictions as a result of COVID-19. Insurance exceeded budget due to the addition of Data Protection/Security Breach coverage. We ended the year with a \$66K surplus which does not account for other post employment benefits and pension liabilities which are reported on the Audited Financial Statement.

2020 Audited Financial Statement

Hillegas reported that a new auditor had been hired in June. The process of selecting an auditor is managed through the Legislative Auditor's office. The audit for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, was conducted virtually with no field visits to the office. Key highlights of the audit findings included that there were no deficiencies identified in our internal controls and that there were no instances of non-compliance with state laws, regulations, contracts, or grant agreements identified.

July 2020 Financial Statements

Hillegas reviewed the July 2020 financial statement noting that all revenues collected in May and June for firm renewals were deferred to July where they appear as income. She reminded the Board members that in response to the stay at home orders issued at the beginning of the pandemic, they had voted to extend the deadline for firm renewals from June 30th to September 30th.

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2019 CE Audit

Hillegas reported that staff had begun the process of conducting a random audit of 5% of licensees to determine compliance with the HSW Continuing Education requirement. There were 171 architects randomly selected consisting of 100 out-of-state and 71 in-state architects. Although letters had been distributed to out-of-state licensees, such were withheld for in-state licensees as they had been scheduled for distribution the week that Hurricanes Marco and Laura hit Louisiana. The Board determined that in-state licensees should be audited, and it directed staff to move forward with audit notification to in-state licensees.

Hillegas shared a communication with the Chief Architect in the State Fire Marshal's Office whereby he outlined the extreme additional workload that architect plan reviewers had taken on this year in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and response to Hurricane Laura. The impact of this work has left these architects with minimal time to pursue CEH or develop and offer the classes that are usually held during their staff meetings.

Motion #5: Blitch/Brinson: That the Board waive the 2020 HSW Continuing Education requirement for the 27 architect plan reviewers employed by the State Fire Marshal's Office as of September 11, 2020. **Passed. 7-0.**

Reporting to the State

Hillegas shared copies of reports which had been prepared in response to a notification from the attorney for the Senate Commerce Committee (our Senate oversight committee) indicating that we were non-compliant with a series of statutorily required reporting requirements. She reported that we were in compliance with some of the items noted in the report, but not with some others. She further reported that she was developing a process to ensure that future compliance with these requirements going forward.

NBTN: Louisiana

Hillegas shared new information provided by NCARB with the 2019 publication of NCARB By The Numbers. The data indicates that Louisiana candidates run slightly behind the national average for completion of the AXP (4.8 years vs. 4.4 year national average) and ARE (2.3 years vs 2.4 years). It also revealed that our candidates perform slightly below the national average (49% vs. 52%) for exam success. It further revealed that we have more reciprocal licensees than the national average.

2021 Officers

Bacque and Brinson will share the role of Chair for 2021, with Bacque serving from January through June and Brinson from July through December. Each will fill the position of Secretary when not serving as Chair.

Office Updates

Hillegas reported that staff had completed a transition to Office 365/Teams which allows for greater protection of local files. She indicated that all documentation now resides in the Cloud except for Laserfiche.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Motion #6: LeBlanc/Blitch: To adjourn. Passed. 7-0.


