The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted March 4, 2016. Dr. DeGrange, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Jackson and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.
