Lots of ideas led to a recommendation to appoint a committee to be termed "Reservoir Naming Committee". Chairman Pierce appointed Bill Jenkins as chairman of the committee along with M. Burris and R. Pierce to collect name data and report back to the commission. There will be a ninety (90) day window for the public to submit suggestions to the committee for the reservoir name. After the ninety (90) days the committee will consider all input and make a recommendation to the Commission.
