Agenda Item #4 (attachment #1) (A) Presentation – Analysis of Qualifications relative Engineering, Surveying & related Technical Services

Washington Parish Reservoir Consultant Mike Thompson gave a presentation on the evaluation criteria set for selecting an Engineering firm for the reservoir project. Mr. Thompson stated that responses returned were from Denmon Engineering and The Shaw Group. Mr. Thompson stated that the requested proposals reflected an outline for the phases needed to take the project from 'cradle to grave' for the reservoir project. The criteria were listed in the request with specialized experience and qualifications. The proposals were reviewed and analyzed with the criteria applied. An analysis was given to the executive board with the Executive Board having a recommendation.

(B) Recommendation (attachment #2)

Chairman Pierce reminded the commission that the process set-up for selection of an engineering firm was that the consultant present an analysis summary of the evaluation to the Executive Committee and the committee was charged with making sure that all areas of the proposal were covered and make a recommendation to the full commission.

Chairman Pierce presented Denmon engineering as the recommendation of the Executive Committee. General discussion was held concerning qualifications and questions were posed to Mr. Thompson concerning the criteria and for the recommendation of Denmon.

Chairman Pierce called for a vote on the recommendation of the Executive Committee to employ Denmon Engineering as the engineering firm on the project. The motion carried with one opposition vote cast by Mike Burris.

There being no further business brought before the commission the meeting was adjourned.
