Minutes Board of Regents' Proprietary Schools Advisory Commission May 9, 2023

The Louisiana Board of Regents' Proprietary Schools Advisory Commission met Tuesday, May 9, 2023, in Room 153 in the Claiborne Building. Chair James Fontenot called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. The roll was then called by Ms. Courtney Britton and a quorum was established. There were no public comments to be read.

The first item of business was the approval of minutes from the Commission's meeting on March 14, 2023.

The next item considered by the Commission was initial license applications. The only initial license application was from Cooper's Defensive Driving School, located in Violet, LA. The school was represented by owner, Ms. Sherleen Cooper.
