A public notice was read aloud into a resolution to consider assessing an adjusted millage rate and a resolution setting the adjusted millage rates for the year 2016.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cheramie, seconded by Commissioner Pizani and unanimously agreed to bid out the grass cutting at the Commercial Dock annually and to get the attorney approval on the wording of the grass cutting.


A motion was made by Commissioner Besson, seconded by Commissioner Pizani with Commissioner Chighizola voting no to pay the Pal dues of \$1,000.00 for the 2016 calendar year.

President Sevin thanked everyone for being "team" players in helping to get the millage renewed and continue to operate the port.

A motion was made by Commissioner Chighizola, seconded by Commissioner Besson and unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 1:22 p.m.
