

## TERREBONNE LEVEE & CONSERVATION DISTRICT



## Regular Meeting Minutes December 7, 2022

President Anthony Alford called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on December 7, 2022.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Alford, Cenac, Chauvin, Daisy, Davis, Henry, Moore and Williams. Commissioner Walker is recorded as absent.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated November 16, 2022. The motion passed without objection.

Under Public, there was no one wishing to address the board.

Under Management's Report, Greg Gautreaux had nothing to report.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Chairman Moore asked the board to approve a cost of living adjustment for TLCD line staff in the amount of 5%, with 3% for the two management staff, and no increase at this time for the executive director, to be effective on January 1, 2023.
