## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Raymond J. Brandt.

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Chairman Brandt welcomed Mr. Robert "Bob" Israel, President of Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association, to the meeting. Mr. Israel advised the Commission Members during the 2010 legislative session HB 1489 (Act No. 1046) and HB1058 (Act No. 936) were passed. Mr. Israel continued by stating HB 1489 which became effective August 15, 2010, enacted LSA-R.S. 32:1264.1, and required a dealer to give the following notice to a prospective buyer on the buyer's order in a box and in bold print which is signed by the buyer and the seller or his representative next to the box:

"A new motor vehicle may have been subject to a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration required recall which would be repaired in accordance with manufacturer standards approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. If such a repair is a concern before you purchase, please ask for a copy of the recall notice, if applicable, to the vehicle being sold."

Additionally, Mr Israel stated HB1058 becomes effective January 1, 2011, enacted LSA-R.S. 6:969.18 G and which required a seller or extender of credit to provide to the consumer written disclosure on the bill or sale, buyer's order, or sales contract regarding the amount of documentation and compliance fees charged to the consumer as follows:

"This fee is authorized by R.S. 6:969.18(A)(2). It is not a mandatory state fee. The seller, who may also be an extender of credit, may charge the fee for credit investigation, compliance with federal and state law, preparation of the documents necessary to perfect or satisfy a lien upon the objects sold, and any other functions incidental to the titling of the retail sale."

Mr. Israel presented to the Commission Members a Buyer's Order which incorporated the language required by HB 1489 and HB 1058 for their review and requesting the Commission approval of the form which LADA feels would constitute a safe harbor for the dealers who would utilize the form. After much discussion, the Commission deferred this matter until Commission Counsel and the Commission could study the form and the provisions of law.

The following judgment was rendered:

This cause came to be heard on Monday, October 18, 2010.

- 1. Marine Manufacturing, Inc. was served with notice of the hearing set in this matter originally for September 20, 2010;
- 2. the September 20, 2010 hearing was continued at the request of Marine Manufacturing, Inc. to October 18, 2010:
- 3. Marine Manufacturing, Inc. received notice of the rescheduled hearing;
- 4. Marine Manufacturing, Inc. advised the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission that it would not attend the October 18, 2010 hearing;
- 5. Marine Manufacturing, Inc. did not request that the October 18, 2010 hearing be rescheduled, and
- 6. Marine Manufacturing, Inc. was not present for the October 18, 2010 hearing;

And after hearing the testimony adduced, the receipt of documentary evidence into the record, and for reasons orally assigned, the Commissioners of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission make the following finding of fact and conclusion of law:

Finding of Fact:

Marine Manufacturing, Inc. engaged in the business as a manufacturer and or distributor in Louisiana

without being licensed by the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission.

Conclusion of Law:

Marine Manufacturing, Inc. is in violation of Louisiana Revised Statutes, Title 9, Section (A)(1) requiring Marine Manufacturing, Inc. to be licensed by the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission as

a manufacturer.

Considering the forgoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission as set forth in Louisiana Revised Statutes, Title 9, Sections 1251, et .seq.,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Marine Manufacturing, Inc., 1125 Magnolia Street, Douglas, Georgia 31533 be and is hereby assessed a fine in the amount of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) AND NO/100 DOLLARS payable to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$7,500.00) AND NO/100 DOLLARS of this fine is to be suspended conditioned upon Marine Manufacturing, Inc., 1125 Magnolia Street, Douglas, Georgia 31533, obtaining a recreational product manufacturer license within thirty (30) days of receipt of this judgment.

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The Executive Director requested the Commission to make a motion to put Hearing #2010-044, Bent Marine, Inc. versus Silverton Marine Corporation on agenda. In attendance was: Greg Bent, dealer-operator of Bent Marine, Inc. However, no one present from Silverton Marine Corporation. A court reporter was brought in to record the transcript

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of this hearing, which will be made a permanent part of the Commission's files. During this hearing Greg Bent advised the Commission Members representatives of Silverton Marine and himself had been in negotiations this date via the telephone and have tentatively resolved the matter. The Commission continued the hearing until the December, 2010 meeting to allow time for the resolution to be come finalized at which time the hearing would be dismissed.

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The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence dated October 2, 2010, from Mark Hebert, Dealer-Operator of Bob Post Chrysler of Shreveport, Inc. DBA Hebert's Town and Country Dodge Chrysler Jeep:

"The dodge dealers of Northwest Louisiana and the Sunbelt Dodge Dealers Association are working with The State Fair of Louisiana for the third year to have Dodge be a presenting sponsor of the 2010 State Fair to be held October 21 - November 7, 2010. We believe this will be a tremendous opportunity to showcase our products to over 400,000 people who attend this State Fair. Chrysler has for years worked with the Texas State Fair and it has been very successful. We would like to be able to promote our Dodge products by displaying cars and trucks at various points throughout the Fair. In addition, Dodge is planning on bringing a display trailer and will have product specialist for two weeks of the Fair. This is a great opportunity for us to have this event. This team will be hired by Dodge and it will be about product presentations and Dodge trucks, there will be no selling involved. We will not have any dealership sales representative on site.

The cars and trucks on display will be provided by Hebert's Town and Country Dodge and Landers Dodge. We would like to have the permission from the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission to make this State Fair a success. I look forward to hearing from you."

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Fabre made a motion to approve Hebert's Town and Country Dodge and Landers Dodge's sponsorship of the 2010 State Fair for vehicle display only and the Law and the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Commission being strictly adhered to and all representations made in the request correspondence of October 2, 2010, remaining constant. Commissioner Westbrook seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

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With regard to old business from the August 16, 2010 meeting regarding the selling of FEMA trailers and the Used Motor Vehicle Commission wherein Counselor Reggie had stated the Used Motor Vehicle Commission delegation would discuss the matter with the Used Motor Vehicle Commission at their next regularly scheduled meeting and report back to the LMVC, the Executive Director present to the Commission Members Derek Parnell's, Executive Director of the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle Commission, response regarding their August 16, 2010 Commission meeting:

"Prior to the Commission meeting, some of our Commissioners had concerns and wanted a representative from the Louisiana Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission (LPGas Commission) to come and speak to the Commission about their requirements. I contacted John Alario, Executive Director for the LPGas Commission. He and his Chief Investigator (Mr. McClain) were in attendance to help explain the requirements of the LPGas Commission. The LPGas representatives discussed the requirements that must take place with the inspections prior to the sale. Also, representatives from one of the Auctioneers was in attendance and participated in the discussion.

The Chairman had spoken to our attorney about drafting a document to help clarify a Rule. Within the document it states, "In the interest of public safety and welfare, the Commission finds it necessary to require all used motor vehicle dealers and auctions to meet all agency laws and regulations with regard to the sale of used recreational vehicles. In particular, the Commission finds that used motor vehicle dealers and auctions must have all documents and /or certificates from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission prior to the sale of any used recreational vehicle which uses any type of propane gas system. The failure to have the proper documentation / certificate at the time of the sale will constitute a violation of the Commission's laws, specifically LSA- RS 32:792(B)(2) committing a fraudulent act in selling, purchasing, or dealing in used motor vehicles, and/or LSA- RS 32:792(B)(3) engaging in his business in a manner to cause injury to the public or to those with whom he is dealing." The Commission went forward and adopted this document as Rule. The Commission will not move forward with the Emergency Rule.

Discussion was held to address the concerns of the Commission's current Rule in place for Established Place of Business. The Commission looked at each line of the Rule and discussed what it means. Two areas in particular were discussed, regularly occupied by a person and shall not mean, temporary quarters.

The first area of concern regularly occupied by a person. The term is subjective to the governing body that uses the term, meaning, that governing body determines what regularly occupied means. I explained that the LMVC interprets in the Rule, regularly occupied by a person to mean someone on site everyday conducting the business, easily accessible to the public during business hours. Both Commissions agree that someone must be easily accessible to the public but there is a slight variation with the interpretation. With the LUMVC, the practice is that if on the application office hours are listed (i.e. 8am - 7pm, M-Sat) the dealer or a representative MUST be at the location during those business hours. If someone is not there during the listed business hours that is a violation of the LUMVC. If on the application, the applicant states that the office hours are "By Appointment Only" then the dealer must be easily accessible. With all calls or communication a representative must be easily

accessible. In most instances, dealers that use this form of office hours forward all calls and communications. If the dealer is not easily accessible when the "By Appointment Only" indication is used, that is a violation of the LUMVC.

The second or the primary area of concern was the "pop-up" auctions, or temporary auctions that move around. The Rule: Shall not mean tents, temporary stands, lots, or temporary quarters. The LUMVC does not condone these "pop-up" auctions wherein the company pops in for a couple of days and disappears. In those situations, if problems arise, there will be absolutely no source of contact or recourse if the seller cannot be found. The LUMVC currently does not issue temporary licenses. The auctions that are licensed have been licensed for the entire year. Those auctions meet all requirements to hold a Used Dealer and Auction License with this Commission (Surety Bond 20K to 35K, Cert of Insurance min. 55K, meet local zoning requirements, permanent enclosed structure, easily accessible, signage, files onsite, phone line and lastly site inspection). The auctions that are licensed are leasing, or in some cases, purchasing the land upon which these auctions are being held. At the location that is licensed, the structure, files, signage and other requirements must remain onsite. All of the pop up auctions that are operating and/or trying to operate without being licensed is illegal activity. When it is brought to my attention or one of my investigators they will go to the site and deal with those offenders. We try to catch all of them but with the limited number of investigators (4) it is a problem that we understand. I have instructed staff and Investigators to keep on the look out for these types of auctions as they are detrimental to consumers and licensees that are properly following rules and regulations.

In the LUMVC's Rule a Used Dealer may have an additional location. The term "2nd location" is not the correct terminology that should be used. The additional location as well as all locations must meet all the requirements prescribed in the law. A location is considered an additional location if and only if the name remains the same. If the name of the location differs from the primary location it is not considered an additional location but a free standing location. In both circumstances, the licensing requirements do not differ from licensing requirements discussed earlier in email. All requirements must be met to hold a license from the LUMVC. During the May Commission meeting and after discussion, the Commission decided to adopt an additional Rule. Within the Rule it states, " A licensed dealer which conducts a public or retail auction at a location other than the dealers primary established place of business must include the address and telephone number of the dealers primary established place of business together with a telephone number to be used during the auction on all signs and bills of sale and shall obtain a public or retail auction license for the auction location prior to advertising the auction." The licensee must be easily accessible at all times during the license period.

All efforts have been made to ensure compliance with all laws, if a license has been issued in the past on a temporary basis it should not have been. It is not the intent of this Commission to contradict a documented law. I assure you it will not happen again. As I stated to you when I initially contacted you upon my hire, my goal is to act and make decisions within the parameters of the law. I do not condone any deviation from the law. Please understand this is my recollection of discussions. I have attempted to give you all information from the Commission meeting as there is nothing I am trying to hide. I appreciate the great working relationship that the LMVC and the LUMVC currently have and believe it will only get stronger."

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding this matter and public auctions vs wholesale auctions.

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The Executive Director reminded the Commission Members Act No. 1036 of the 2010 Legislative Session enacted:

LSA-R.S. 32:1254(B)(1)(b) Commencing January 1, 2011, licenses shall be issued for a term of two years initially staggering the two-year license so Commission Districts 1,3, 5, and 7 will be issued a one-year license in 2011 and a two-year license thereafter. Recreational product license fees shall be prorated to cover the period from December 31, 2010, until license renewal.

Additionally, LSA-R.S. 32:1255 was amended so that the fees were for each year covered by the license. The Executive Director presented the Commission with the following chart for better understanding.

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The Executive Director advised the Commission Members, due to unforeseen legal expenses relative to recreational products licensing and increasing cases of litigations, Counselor Reggie had exceeded the limits of the contract and requested the following amendment to the contract be approved: "The total of all sums payable under this contract including fees and reimbursement of expenses shall not exceed \$170,000.00 for the period commencing February 1,2010 and ending on January 31, 2011." After a brief discussion, Commissioner Corley made a motion to approve the amendments to Counselor Reggie's current contract. Commissioner Duhon seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

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The Executive Director advised the Commission Members, due to unforeseen legal expenses relative to recreational products licensing and increasing cases of litigations, Counselor LaPeyronnie had exceeded the limits of the contract and requested the following amendment to the contract be approved: "The total of all sums payable under this contract including fees and reimbursement of expenses shall not exceed \$99,000.00 for the period commencing January 12, 2010 and ending on January 11, 2011." After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to approve the amendments to Counselor LaPeyronnie's current contract. Commissioner Duhon seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

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The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members for their information the 2010 Fiscal Audit Report prepared by Griffin & Company, LLC.

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In a discussion involving budgetary matters the Commission considered several suggestions to increase revenue and reduce expenditures. After discussion, it was decided that the Recreational Product(s) Manufacturer's licensing fee would be raised from \$100 per year to \$500 per year to more closely account for the actual cost of issuing such licenses. Commissioner LeBlanc made a motion to raise the Recreational Product(s) Manufacturer's license fee to \$500 per year. Commissioner Hicks seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved. After further discussion, it was decided that the Commission would set standard Commission costs of \$300 per pre-hearing to be assessed to the licensee in the discretion of the commission after considering the merits of the complaint, and that a standard fee of \$300 per hour, to be split by the parties, would be charged to parties utilizing the Commission for informal mediation services, these charges being a good faith estimate of the actual costs associated with these functions. Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to set standard Commission costs of \$300 per pre-hearing to be assessed to the licensee in the discretion of the commission after considering the merits of the complaint, and to set the standard fee of \$300 per hour, to be split by the parties, utilizing the Commission for informal mediation services. Commissioner Duhon seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved. Additionally, as a cost saving measure, it was determined to hold Commission meeting every other month, unless a matter of urgency or a hearing needs to be heard by the Commission.

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The Executive Director advised the Commission Members a pre-hearing had been on August 16, 2010, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 49:961C, regarding B-2010-026, Supreme Chevrolet, L.L.C.,13354 Airline Highway, Gonzales, Louisiana 70737, for alleged violations of LSA-R.S.32:1261(2)(c) Unauthorized Acts; LSA-R.S. Title 46. Part V. Subpart 1. Chapter 7. Advertising §703A. General Prohibition; §719C. Dealer Price Advertising; and §725A. Trade-In Allowances. In attendance representing Supreme Chevrolet, L.L.C. was: David Loeb, counsel for Supreme Chevrolet, L.L.C.; representing the Commission were: Acting Chairman Bill Westbrook; Counselor Gregory F. Reggie; Commission Investigator, Perry Esponge; Assistant Executive Director, Ingya Cattle; and the Executive Director. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members the following Consent Judgment had been recommended by Acting Chairman Westbrook and accepted by the representatives of Supreme Chevrolet, L.L.C.,

if accepted and ratified by the Commission. Commissioner Duhon made a motion to accept and ratify the Consent Judgment in this matter. Commissioner Hocevar seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS of the fine be suspended conditioned upon Supreme Chevrolet, L.L.C.,13354 Airline Highway, Gonzales, Louisiana 70737, being placed on ONE (1) YEAR probation beginning the date this Consent Judgment is rendered and signed and adhering to all Rules and Regulations of this Commission and Louisiana laws applicable to this Commission during the probationary period. In the event of a violation during the probationary period, the suspended portion of the fine shall become due and payable in full.
