Crime Trends Report

Jim Olsen delivered the report of the crime trends in the district for December 2017. For the entire year, crime was reduced 17.9 % compared to the statistics for 2016. Jim explained in general terms where the vehicles are generally deployed within the district and that, during Mardi Gras the numbers of officers who are deployable will be somewhat reduced due to the NOPD parade security requirements. Questions were put to Jim Olsen by various attendees and answers were given.

Financial Statement as of 12/31/17

Jim Olsen delivered a report on the financial status of the district. The cash on hand at the end of December was approximately \$417,000.

Total payroll for the officers was approximately \$916,000 for the year.

Tung Ly reported that the website improvements have been made and he will be keeping it current as needed.

Status of vehicles

New 2016 Tahoe was purchased and should be delivered this week. It will need to be kitted out and put into use. Nos. 1304 and 1305 are very high mileage and will be used as backups to the fleet. The wrecked car was repaired and is back in use.

Crime Reporting Modified App Discussion

Jim Olsen explained to the Board and attendees the mission of the MCSD and the Board's responsibilities to the MCSD. He also explained the responsibilities and limitations of the MCSD detail officers. The Board will

look into a modified application with citizen complaints going to three iPhones that will be monitored by officers.

Wendy Laker suggested that residents in high density developments within the district should be assessed some sort of MCSD fee.
