

**LOUISIANA STATE BOARD OF PRIVATE
SECURITY EXAMINERS**

MEETING MINUTES

JUNE 20, 2019

The regular meeting of the LA STATE BOARD OF PRIVATE SECURITY EXAMINERS was called to order by Chairwoman, Marian Pierre, on Thursday June 20, 2019 at 9:30a.m. at 15703 Old Hammond Hwy, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

Members Misty Finchum, and Ritchie Rivers; were absent. Finding a quorum present, the regular order of business began.

Also attending the meeting were: Executive Director, Fabian Blache III; Board Attorney, Ron Crouch, Executive Assistant, Bridgette Hull, Mr. David Burke (Tectus), Ms. Lisa Beeson (Tactical Impact Security, LLC) Maria Kostulsky (Allied Universal) and LSBPSE staff, Sharon Vallery, Allison Salamoni, Stephanie Richardson, Wendy Aldridge, Cindy Edison. Ms. Hull recorded the meeting minutes!

Mr. Blache led the members and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairwoman Pierre asked that the minutes for March 14, 2019 be read aloud in to the records. Mr. Blache read the minutes into the record. Chairwoman Pierre made a motion that the minutes be excepted, Mr. Robinson seconded the motion which passed without opposition.

Mr. Pellegrin and Mrs. Landry asked why the Board did not have a court reporter at the March meeting and the June meeting of record. Mr. Crouch Advised the Board that it is not mandatory to have a court reporter. Ms. Landry engaged in further questions and discussion concerning the use of court reporters as a practice. Mr. Crouch explained that civil service and other larger agencies simply do not use them, nor incur the expense. State agencies typically and customarily audio record their board and commission meetings, publish a summary of the meeting minutes, and where necessary transcribe the recordings. Mr. Blache let the Board know he will see what he can do to get a court reporter to transcribe the Minutes for the March 14, 2019 meeting—as this was a request from Mr. Pellegrin.

Chairwoman Pierre welcomed Mr. Wayne “Ron” Crouch aboard for serving as part-time legal staff for the Board. Mr. Crouch indicated that he is very happy to be on board. Chairwoman Pierre congratulated Mr. Blache for being named a Louisiana Ambassador and for being the President for International Association of Security & Investigative Regulators—representing the LSBPSE in South Africa as keynote speaker for the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSiRA).

Mrs. Landy indicated that it is an honor that Mr. Blache was representing Louisiana and the Board, and that she knows Mr. Blache represents Louisiana well. Mr. Robinson add that it was a pleasure being at the last IASIR meeting with Mr. Blache to see how everyone looks up to him from his observations at the meeting he attended in Arizona. Mr. Robinsons futher indicated that it is significant because Louisiana is moving forward under Mr. Blache’s direction. Chairwoman Pierre expressed that Louisiana has gone from having a founding IASIR member to having one of our own now leading the international body.
