Nominating Committee	discussed who would make up the nominating committee, who would be tasked with nominating officers for the positions of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer of the AAHSD board.	
Comments from the Executive Director Travel approval discussion and documentation	Brad Farmer shared that he had checked with the state to see if there was a way on an annual basis to have to approve the executive director's travel instead of bringing it to the board each time the district has to pay for his travel. Brad said that the state informed him that could potentially be a red flag. Just for accountability and to make sure no red flags are triggered, Brad said he will present travel expenses for approval to the board each time the district pays for the executive director's travel.	

 Legislative Audit update Brad informed the board that the Compliance and Control Audit, performed by the State Legislative Auditors for the AAHSD, is currently being conducted. He also told the board that the they have already sent the auditors documentation on the district's policy and procedures. Brad then shared that he has also already asked the Legislative Auditors to come and present the audit to the board once it is complete.

Budget presentation to JLCB

Brad talked to the board about budget discussion that have begun, which he said the initial proposal shows cuts to LDH, medicaid, and Developmental Disabilities services. But, he also told the board that the district's budget doesn't look that bad right now. However, he said that doesn't mean much right now because it is so early and some things could change.

 SAMHSA Prevention review

Board members were presented with a calendar that was composed of Saint Landry students' drawings that support being drug free. Brad shared that although the district does not fund this prevention effort in Saint Landry, they are one of its supporters, which is why the AAHSD logo is printed on teh back of the calendar. He also spoke about the Criminal Coordinating Council, and its Justice + Health Collaborative, which is for the purpose of creating access to effective community supports and services along the care continuum and justice intercepts. It was during this discussion that board member Elizabeth West requested that Brad look into what services the district could provide to Evangeline Parish inmates suffering from mental illness. The decision was made to work on setting up a meeting between Brad and criminal justice officials in Evangeline Parish.
