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1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

3 All right. I'll call to order the
4 Board of Certification and Training
for Solid Waste Management Operators
for April the 27th, 2012, meeting at
the Cajundome Convention Center in

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conjunction with the Environmental Conference.

Our Chairman, Mr. Lagrange, has been called away on family business, so as vice president I'll attempt to preside at the meeting.

Ms. Bordelon, would you please call the role?

MS. BORDELON:

Sure. Terrance Stewart?

MR. STEWART:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

James Berthelot?

MR. BERTHELOT:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Scott Lyons?

MR. LYONS:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Delaney Lewis?

(No response.)

MS. BORDELON:

David Guillory?

MR. GUILLORY:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Fred Williams?

MR. WILLIAMS:

Present.

MS. BORDELON:

William Mollere?

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Sam Phillips?

(No response.)

MS. BORDELON:

Denny Mize?

(No response.)

MS. BORDELON:

Henry Lagrange?

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(No response.)

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

We do have a quorum, so we will continue with business.

Do I have a motion on the December 9th minutes?

MR. WILLIAMS:

So moved.

MR. GUILLORY:

Second.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Motion by Mr. Williams, supported by Mr. Guillory.

Any objection?

(No response.)

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Minutes are approved.

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10 Consideration for operation
11 certifications, I think you've all
12 received those through e-mail and
13 there was a second set sent to you.
14 So if we'll go through those and if
15 you have any questions, let's raise
16 them as we go through it.

31 Rouge. He hadn't paid any money.
32 He hadn't sent the money with his
33 application, so he didn't show up on
34 Wednesday to test because he didn't

7 certificates.

Okay. Where is that?

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MS. BORDELON:

No. I have that list because these

Okay. You want to read them?

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MS. BORDELON:

Yes, because these are --

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CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Okay.

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MS. BORDELON:

This is a list of those applications
that approve today or at a previous
meeting and that tested on Wednesday
and passed.

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MR. BERTHELOT:

Motion.

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MR. LYONS:

Second.

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CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Okay. We had a motion, I think, by
Mr. Berthelot, seconded by Mr.
Lyons.

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Any objection?
(No response.)

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CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

So ordered.

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MS. BORDELON:

Now we can go to Lockhart.

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3 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Yes. Okay. Let's go back to Mr.
4 Lockhart.
5 MS. BORDELON:
Again, Mr. Lockhart, he previously
6 held a C&D Level A certification and
he let it lapse, and so he's having
7 to retest in order to get his
certification back again. He has
8 not tested yet again. His --
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
9 But he's come into your office,
right?
10 MS. BORDELON:
His application was approved today
11 again, but he'd like to come into
the office in Baton Rouge and test.
12 And he would like this Board to
approve the issuance of his
13 certificate contingent upon him
passing that test so that he doesn't
14 have to wait until July.
MR. LYONS:
15 Has he completed his ten hours of
classes?
16 MS. BORDELON:
He was here today, yes.
17 MR. LYONS:
He was?
18 MS. BORDELON:
But it really -- I mean, that's kind
19 of irrelevant because he's
retesting.
20 MR. LYONS:
And you have no problem testing him
in the office?
21 MS. BORDELON:
No. In fact, I tested actually nine
22 between December and this
conference.
23 MR. WILLIAMS:
Mr. Chairman, I move.
24 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay. There's a motion that it be
25 approved contingent upon him passing
the test. And it's supported by Mr.

1 Lewis.
Any objection?
2 (No response.)
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
3 So ordered.
All right. All of our
4 certifications are now done,
correct?
5 MS. BORDELON:
Correct.
6 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
All right. Let's go into our
7 committee reports. Mr. Mize is not
here, but I would like to ask that

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8 we ratify those awards that were
9 presented yesterday at lunch. We
had some very fine nominees.

10 We had two for the Bentley
Mackey award. The gentleman who won
11 -- and of course, it's all nominated
from the Board. It was six to three
and --

12 MR. WILLIAMS:

It was close.

13 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

14 We had two very, very fine nominees.
I would suggest in the future -- and
15 this is just me -- that the
nominee's application be filled out
by us and not by the nominee.

16 That was something that I think
we need to know the person well
17 enough that we can make a
nomination. So it was perhaps a
18 little awkward, I think, at one
point.

19 MR. WILLIAMS:

20 Would you like that in the form of a
motion?

21 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

22 I don't know that we need it to be
formalized that way. I think it
ought to just be understood that we
23 control the Bentley Mackey award and
that it should be coming from us
individually.

24 And traditionally we have looked
at people who have rotated off this
25 Board. And maybe that's bad, too.
I wouldn't call it a self-promotion,

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1 but there are a few of us who have
2 been on the Board and when we went
off, we were honored with that.

3 But I think we're looking for
the most outstanding environmental
4 solid waste professional in the
state. And I think we've got quite
5 a few people out there that we can
look to. And may we always have
very fine nominees.

6 Is there any objection to the
way we're doing it?

7 (No response.)

8 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

9 We had three very fine winners, I
think. I'll call on Mr. Mollere for
the testing. Yes, we had 15 tests,
10 12 passed and 3 didn't.

11 Our continuing education, Mr.
Berthelot?

12 MR. BERTHELOT:

Our next conference is in Marksville
in July and then Shreveport in
October.

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CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay. We'll have a flow report on that very shortly.
Mr. Lewis, do you have a nominating report?
MR. LEWIS:
I do not.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay. All right. We'll go into other business and I'll call on Ms. Yolanda Righteous to give us information on the proposed workshops to be held in Marksville and Shreveport, the dates. And I think she has furnished you with a preliminary copy of the workshop agenda.
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Yes.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Welcome.
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Thank you. You have a copy of the agenda. The Marksville workshop is scheduled for July 17th and 18th, and the Shreveport is scheduled for

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October 16th and the 17th.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
That's a Monday and Tuesday in Marksville and a Tuesday and Wednesday in Shreveport?
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
I believe so.
MR. WILLIAMS:
I believe it is.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay.
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Yes, I believe so.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
And we'll be at the casino in Marksville and the Hilton in Shreveport?
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Yes.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay.
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Yes. Day 1 starts at 10:00 and on Day 1 we have six hours. And on Day 2 we have four hours. As you can see, Mr. L.J. Bergeron is going to present two topics, asbestos training and blood-borne pathogens. And then we'll follow up the first day with someone from DEQ. Right now we have Estuardo Silva (spelled phonetically) tentatively scheduled to present a groundwater monitoring talk, sort of A to Z on

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18 groundwater monitoring; why is it
19 necessary, the installation of the
wells, and the sampling of the
wells.

20 And then we'll have Ms. Peggy
21 Sellers that will present on safety
22 training. And our plan is to tailor
that safety training specific to
23 landfill operators so that it is
really relevant to the folks that
will be attending the conference.

24 And we always include role
playing as part of our certification
25 training. It's -- you know, we may
touch on topics, such as disaster
relief, emergency response, landfill

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1 communication, and public outreach.
2 So that's a two-hour session that
involves role playing.

3 On Day 2 we'll start off with
4 air quality compliance at landfills,
and that's going to be presented by
John Forrier, Terrance Stewart --
Honorable Terrance Stewart.

5 MR. WILLIAMS:

Oh, my Lord.

6 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

7 The honorable. The honorable. He's
going to present back-to-back
8 topics, one on the certification
process and equipment maintenance
and safety.

9 And then we'll have two talks
10 presented by Melissa Strickland,
stormwater pollution intervention
11 plans and spill prevention plans.
And she'll talk about the
12 development of these plans, as well
as the implementation of these plans
at landfills.

13 And then we'll follow up with a
14 roundtable discussion, relevant
topics. We'll solicit topics from
15 the attendees when they -- on Day 1
we'll ask for suggestions. But we
16 have some sort of prepared topics
that we think are relevant and that
17 will flow well with the roundtable
discussion.

18 So as you can see, we have our
ten hours pretty much lined out with
19 Day 1 and Day 2.

Any questions?

20 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Any questions on that? We have six
21 hours the first day and then four
hours on Day 2.

22 MR. WILLIAMS:

And both of those conferences, Bill,
are on Tuesday/Wednesday.

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23 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
They are?
24 MR. WILLIAMS:
Yes, both are Tuesday/Wednesday.
25 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Okay. All right. Any questions of

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1 Ms. Righteous?
MR. STEWART:
2 What are the chances of me getting
out of these talks?
3 MR. WILLIAMS:
Slim and none. Take your pick.
4 MS. RIGHTEOUS:
That's a "no." Yes.
5 MR. STEWART:
Just thought I'd try.
6 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Well, I'm sure if they could find
7 somebody better, but that's probably
a --
8 MS. RIGHTEOUS:
That's the problem.
9 MR. STEWART:
Well, that's going to be hard.
10 MR. WILLIAMS:
That's why you have to do them,
11 because we can't find anybody any
better than you, Terrance.
12 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
You're it.
13 (OFF THE RECORD)
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
14 Okay. Do I have a motion?
MR. WILLIAMS:
15 So moved.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
16 Mr. Stewart has a motion that this
be approved for ten hours and Mr.
17 Williams has ordered that.
Is there any objection?
18 (No response.)
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
19 So ordered. Thank you, Ms.
Righteous.
20 MS. RIGHTEOUS:
Thank you.
21 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
We'll look forward to Marksville and
22 to Shreveport. We appreciate the --
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
23 May I be excused?
MR. WILLIAMS:
24 No. We need you. No.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
25 Well, yes, you may. We'd like for
you to stay, but that's okay.

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1 We have been requested by Mr.
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2 Hugh Till, Buddy Till, who
3 previously was a member of this
4 Board and Chairman of this Board, to
5 be issued a lifetime certification,
6 as we have done for a number of
7 other members who have stepped off
8 of this Board.

9 Mr. Till has been very, very
10 active in the solid waste area. He
11 and his wife were here for this
12 conference and attended and
13 participated in it.

14 I don't know what I can say
15 about his work, but I know he was
16 very, very instrumental in moving
17 this Board of Certification forward
18 and did a lot of good things while
19 he was active, and particularly when
20 he was Chairman.

21 So I would entertain a motion
22 that he be issued lifetime
23 certification.

24 MR. BERTHELOT:

25 So moved.

MR. LEWIS:

Second.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Mr. Berthelot moves. Mr. Lewis
supports.

Is there any objection?
(No response.)

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

So ordered.

In your folders or the
information sent to you, you
probably saw where United Rentals,
Mr. Roller, Dave Roller had asked to
have approval of on-time training
classes.

If you've had a chance to look
over that, the history of that was
that they have come to us previously
and asked for that. I think in 2009
this Board approved five hours.
When I looked over the agenda, I
really couldn't find more than that.

I mean, it was interesting what
he plans to do and I think Ms.
Bordelon has indicated that we have

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1 never had anybody come back and
2 claim those five hours. So I would
3 leave it up to what the Board would
4 like to do, if you want to, again,
5 approve five hours or just pass.

MR. BERTHELOT:

Ms. Bordelon, what's your idea on
that?

MS. BORDELON:

Basically I think it's the same
classes that we've already -- that

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7 this Board has already approved.
8 He's just looking to do those
9 classes online rather than a, you
10 know, classroom type setting. And
11 he's asking, I think, for the five
12 hours again for each class.

13 And again, since 2009 we've
14 never had anybody submit a
15 certificate from any of his classes.

16 MR. BERTHELOT:

17 So it's not being abused, then?

18 MS. BORDELON:

19 No.

20 MR. GUILLORY:

21 Or used.

22 MR. BERTHELOT:

23 Or used, yes.

24 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

25 What's your pleasure?

MR. BERTHELOT:

Well, if it's not being abused, I
have no problem with it.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Okay. You make a motion?

MR. BERTHELOT:

Yes, sir, sure do.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Is there support? Mr. Lewis?

MR. LEWIS:

Yes, I'll support.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

All right. And moved by Mr.
Berthelot. Seconded by Mr. Lewis.

Is there any objection?

(No response.)

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

So ordered.

We also have a request from Mr.
Billy Warden in Mississippi with

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1 their Solid Waste Association of
2 North America. They have a very
3 active chapter over there and they
4 are having their annual conference
5 at the Hollywood Casino in Bay St.
6 Louis. And they have asked us to
7 look into giving them credit for
8 those who would attend.

9 Mr. Warden and I go way back in
10 the solid waste areas. He's a very
11 good friend, a very good man. And
he called me and I asked him to
submit the agenda to Ms. Bordelon so
that this Board would have an
opportunity to look over it.

12 I checked very carefully and
13 looked at all of the hours
14 personally again. I found just over
15 nine hours. Strangely enough, nine
16 and a quarter hours. I don't know
17 what the rest of you found. That's

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including the two hours on the landfill tour.

So some of you may have looked at it differently or see other hours, but certainly the floor is open for discussion on whether we want to approve the training classes there.

He asked mainly because there may be people from Louisiana who would go to that conference and want to be certified and receive credit here in Louisiana.

MR. BERTHELOT:

Mr. Bill, how many hours is he asking for?

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Well, he'd like to have the ten hours.

MR. BERTHELOT:

Ten. Ms. Bordelon, have you gone through it?

MS. BORDELON:

No, I have not.

MR. GUILLORY:

Do we have a chapter, a SWANA chapter, in Louisiana?

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Yes. Yes.

MR. GUILLORY:

Okay.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Yes, we do. Matter of fact, the annual meeting will be at Marksville.

MR. GUILLORY:

Really? Okay.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

Any other comments?
(No response.)

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

What's the pleasure of the Board?

MR. BERTHELOT:

We've done that in the past.

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

We have.

MR. GUILLORY:

SWANA usually does a good job.

MR. LYONS:

Do they do it for us? Will they do the same thing for us?

CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:

In the past we've worked with them and participated and actually cosponsored and been one of the cosponsors over there. And at that time we had, you know, the ten-hour reciprocity. So --

MR. STEWART:

I'll make a motion, Mr. Bill.

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17 MR. LYONS:
Well, I mean, as long as it's
18 reciprocal.
MR. STEWART:
19 Yes, if they do it for us, so that
we do it for them.
MR. LYONS:
20 Yes.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
21 Okay. Mr. Stewart made the motion
and Mr. Lyons seconds.
22 Is there any objection?
(No response.)
23 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
24 All right. Then we will notify Mr.
Warden that this Board of
25 Certification will grant ten hours
for anyone who comes back with the
proper information and certification

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1 from the Mississippi SWANA Chapter.
All right. This brings us to
2 remarks for the good of the order,
public comments, questions.
3 MR. WILLIAMS:
4 Mr. Chairman, I'd just like to go on
record and hopefully I'm speaking
5 for the entire Board when I say that
I'd like to commend Ms. Righteous
6 for the outstanding job that she
does not only at this conference,
7 but also at our workshops. I think
she's doing a fabulous job and I'd
8 just like for the Board to support
me in commending her for the job
9 that she does.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
10 Absolutely.
MS. RIGHTEOUS:
11 Is that on the record?
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
12 Rose petals. Rose petals. I think
all of you know Ms. Righteous is the
13 conference chairperson for this and
she's also in charge of the
14 workshops, so she puts that together
with the able assistance of a couple
15 of other people. But she is the
leader and we do appreciate it.
MR. STEWART:
16 Her Highness.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
17 All right. Yes, sir?
MR. BERTHELOT:
18 Move to adjourn.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
19 There is a motion.
MR. WILLIAMS:
20 Second.
CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
21 There is support.

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Any objection?
(No response.)
23 CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
Thank you, all.
