- 2) Chairman Frank Besson opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. The prayer was led by Shirley Bourg.
- A MOTION was made by Shirley Bourg to approve the Board meeting minutes of March 19, 2014. The motion was seconded by Kevin Marcel. No opposition. The motion passed.
- 4) A MOTION was made by Amy Mathews to approve the Investment Committee minutes of April 16, 2014. The motion was seconded by Andrea Hubbard. No opposition. The motion passed.
- Rob Bickham reviewed the monthly asset allocation and the market value and returns summary as of April 30, 2014 (See Exhibit A on file at LSPR office).
- Kristin Leto presented the Check Registers for the period from March 1, 2014 to March 31, 2014 and April 1, 2014 to April 30, 2014, the Statement of Plan Net Assets and Budget Summary as of April 30, 2014 (See Exhibit B on file at LSPRS office).

A **MOTION** was made by Kevin Marcel to accept the Financial Reports. The **MOTION** was seconded by Amy Mathews. No opposition. The motion passed.

7) Irwin Felps gave an update on the Legislative Session, discussing the SB 16, which is the bill regarding the COLA. This bill was passed giving all retirees that are 60 years of age by July 1, 2014 and retired at least one year, a 1.5% COLA, and all retirees 65 and older by July 1, 2014 an additional 2% COLA.

The other bill discussed was HB 1225, sponsored by Representative Joel Robideaux and Senator Elbert Guillory. HB 1225 is a companion bill that will modify our current experience account legislation. In general, it will change how our system puts money into the experience account. It will also change how much we can pay as COLAs and how frequently we can pay a COLA. - 8) Kimberly Gann gave an update on the implementation of the COLA. As of now everything will be in place for July to award the COLA to the qualifying retirees.
- 9) A MOTION was made by Shirley Bourg to approve the following retirement/DROP Approvals and elimination of benefits and/or awarding of benefits to survivor(s) noting that all paperwork is in order. 
