ITEM NO. 1

Sen. Alario requested a motion for approval of the minutes of the June 18, 2015, meeting as presented to the board. Lt. Governor Dardenne moved to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion passed with no objection.

Sen. Alario asked Mr. Henson to explain item No. 3. Mr. Henson stated that the State Treasurer's Office had reviewed the applications of the following three financial institutions (banks and credit unions) that had applied for designation as a state depository/fiscal agent for the remainder of the four-year period ending June 30, 2019:

- 1. Bank of Abbeville & Trust Company, Abbeville
- 2. Homeland Federal Savings Bank, Columbia

3. Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, San Francisco, CA

Mr. Henson further explained that upon review of the three applications, the State Treasurer's Office had made its recommendation for approval.

Mr. Henson moved for IEB approval; second by Rep. Fannin. The motion passed with no objection.
