Ms. Theriot had received multiple inquiries from sheriff offices regarding the accreditation of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) for deputies who have completed and passed a POST certified training from another state. The board discussed and concluded, that contact should be made to the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement for the agency to advise as to the equivalent level of Louisiana state certification to determine if the deputy's certificate would qualify for supplemental pay. The board also reclarified that per the DSSP manual, the sheriff must have at least one year of service in Louisiana.
