Mr. Bennett moved approval of the minutes for the October 7, 2024, meeting, seconded by Ms. Hutchinson, and without objection, the minutes were approved.

Mr. Bennett moved approval, seconded by Ms. Hutchinson that Ms. Theriot as Support Staff of the DSSP Board would request payment for the deputies submitted.

Item 4 – Chairwoman Horton and the other members of the subcommittee request that each supplemental pay review board and state agency administering a supplemental pay program submit suggestions, recommendations, or concerns that they may have regarding the existing program structure. Mr. Bennett pointed out that 50% rule has created challenges with sheriffs as deputies do a variety of job duties that can vary depending on the circumstances. Mr. Bennett stated that the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association is working with legal staff, the Legislative Auditors, and the subcommittee to review the definition of a law enforcement officer, add prohibited job titles, and review legislation with reference to language for law enforcement supervisory positions. The board reclarified that per the DSSP manual, the deputy shall not be eligible for additional compensation out of state funds if the deputy is hired primarily to perform purely clerical or non-enforcement duties.
