### CERTIFICATION OF INABILITY TO OPERATE DUE TO LACK OF QUORUM

In accordance with Executive Proclamations JBE 2020-84 and 2020-89 issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on June 25, 2020, and July 11, 2020, respectively, this notice shall serve as a certification of the Louisiana State Bond Commission's inability to otherwise operate in accordance with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law due to a lack of a quorum as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Pursuant to Section 2(C) of JBE 2020-84, the Louisiana State Bond Commission will provide for attendance at its essential government meeting on July 16, 2020, via video conference because it is unable to obtain a quorum (8 of 14 members). In addition, under Section 3 of JBE 2020-89 Governor Edwards ordered all indoor crowd sizes limited to no more than fifty (50) people. The Louisiana State Bond Commission is composed of fourteen (14) members and would likely have a total indoor crowd at the meeting, including staff and the public, greater than fifty (50) people. It is essential for the Louisiana State Bond Commission to continue to operate because it must approve the issuance of any bonds, or other obligations, of the state and any political subdivision of the state under La. Const. art. VII, §8(B).

Considering the foregoing, and in accordance with Proclamation Numbers JBE 2020-84 and 2020-89, the Louisiana State Bond Commission's meeting on Thursday, July 16, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. will be held via video conference and in a manner that allows for observation and input by members of the public, as set forth in the Notice posted on July 14, 2020.
